SYMPTOMS OF CHILD ABUSE

A child who's being abused may feel guilty, ashamed, or confused. He or she may be afraid to tell anyone about the abuse, especially if the abuser is a parent, other relative, or family friend. That's why it's vital to watch for red flags:

- ⇒ Withdrawal from friends or usual activities
- ⇒ Changes in behavior, such as aggression, anger, hostility, or hyperactivity, or changes in school performance
- ⇒ Depression, anxiety, or unusual fears, or a sudden loss of self-confidence
- ⇒ An apparent lack of supervision
- ⇒ Frequent absences from school
- ⇒ Reluctance to leave school activities, as if he or she doesn't want to go home
- ⇒ Attempts at running away
- ⇒ Rebellious or defiant behavior
- ⇒ Self-harm or attempts at suicide

Specific signs and symptoms depend on the type of abuse and can vary. Keep in mind that these signs are just that — warning signs, not necessarily proof that a child is being abused.

THIS WEEK'S QUESTION

- Q. Did St. John really take care of Mother Mary after Jesus died?
- A. When Jesus was on the cross, both the apostle John and Mary, mother of Jesus, stood nearby. "When Jesus saw his mother there, and the disciple whom he loved standing nearby, he said to her, 'Woman, here is your son,' and to the disciple, 'Here is your mother.' From that time on, this disciple took her into his home." The clear understanding of the passage is that Jesus commanded John to care for Mary after his death. She probably continued to stay with John in Jerusalem until her death. Tradition says that Mary died in either AD 43 or AD 48, but we have no way of confirming that.

St. John was the youngest apostle. He outlived all the other apostles and was the only one of the twelve to die of natural causes.

Scripture clearly teaches the importance of caring for widows and the elderly, something Jesus personally applied during His final hours of His earthly ministry.

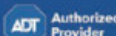
