### Reflection from Sr. Gail

The word love is thrown around so loosely these days. But the love spoken of in the gospel is not common. The type of love spoken of in the gospel is the love God has shared with his disobedient children for thousands of years. It is a love that endures all hardships. It is a love that is ready to begin again after mistakes have been made. It is a love that does not judge. It is a love that perseveres with patience.

God calls parish communities to this same type of love. It is sincere, and is not in the same category as "romantic" love. Romantic love can fall in one day, and out the next. The type of love God calls communities to is the love that can withstand the test of time. That means with God in the center nothing can deter a community from staying together, working to help each other rise to their highest godly potential, nor forgiving one another and beginning again.

When communities mirror God's love they grow in faith, hope and endurance. It's not about just coming together; it becomes celebrating the greatness that rises from learning how to become the greater love of God together. Have you committed to God's challenge to become community, by growing in faith, hope and love together?
