

GRIEF SUPPORT


These sessions will once again be held on the second Thursday of the month at 6:00 PM in the Seton Room.



A Christmas Carol is a song or hymn on the theme of Christmas, traditionally sung around the Christmas holiday season. Traditional carols tell the story of the Nativity and almost all of them were written prior

to the 1800's. Sometimes we think that these songs have been sung since the birth of Christ, but that is not true at all. The oldest known Christmas carol is a 4th century Latin poem that was later written as a <u>plainchant</u> (liturgical music that has no meter and one voice – similar to Gregorian Chant) during the 12th century and it is translated to <u>"Of The Father's Love Begotten"</u>. This Christmas hymn serves as a reminder that Jesus is the promised Messiah. If you attended the 4:00pm Christmas Eve Mass, our choir sung this ancient Christmas hymn. The picture shown is of Plainchant and is the original "Of the Father's Love Begotten"
