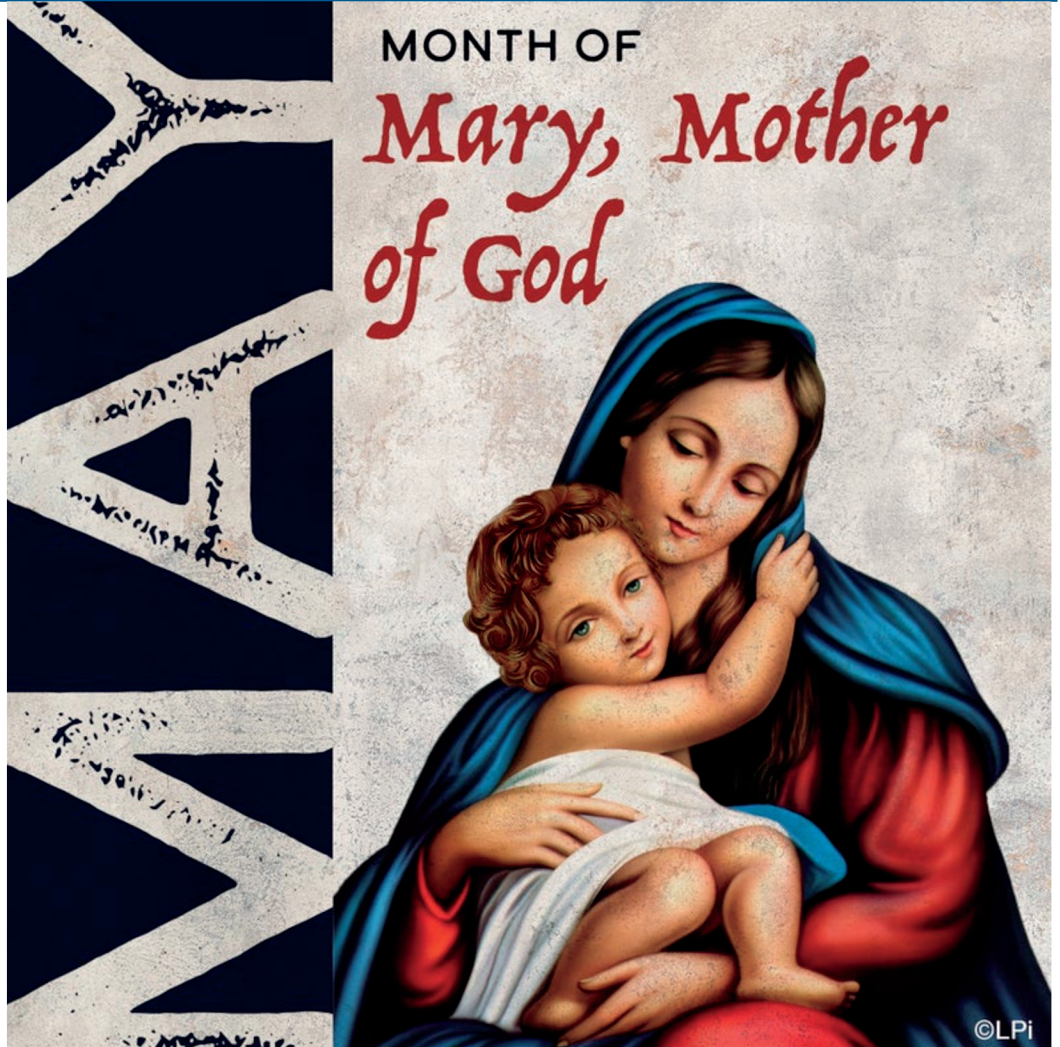

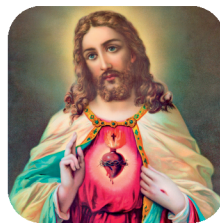
ROSARY

WALKING WITH MOMS IN NEED

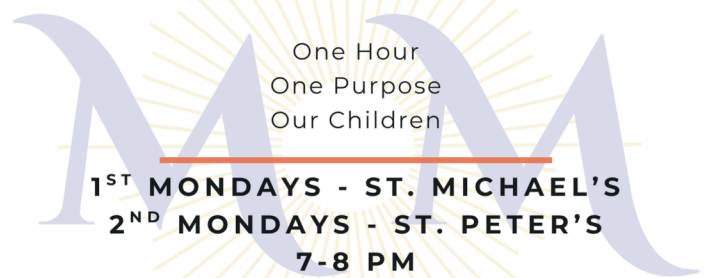
