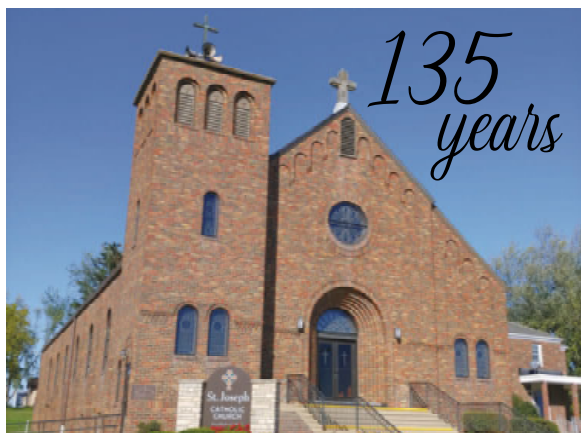




**BUDGET ENVELOPES ~** for 2022 are in the church basement. Please pick yours up and deliver to your friends and neighbors if possible.
