
SACRAMENT OF MARRIAGE

On January 22nd, the United States marks a sad anniversary of the Roe v. Wade Supreme Court decision which helped legalize abortion throughout the country. Pope Francis in a recent press interview put it plainly, "...abortion: it's more than a problem, it's homicide, whoever has an abortion, kills. No mincing words." (vaticannews.va) As Catholics and Americans, we strive for justice and freedom in our society as a call from Jesus Christ. While there are many issues that we are attentive to, the destruction of life in the womb is a unique cause for sadness, and for Christians to pray and do penance for its end. The USCCB: United States Conference of Catholic Bishops has decreed that January 22nd is a day of Prayer for the Legal Protection of Unborn Children. We should work to change laws and our culture for the respect and preservation of life. On Saturday, please spend some time in prayer for the unborn. Consider a holy hour (or some time) before the Eucharist, or a rosary, asking the Lord to change hearts and minds. Take up a penance that day as well, to deny ourselves some comfort to unite ourselves to the suffering of others and to the Cross of Christ which provides all Grace. A day without meat, or alcohol, or sweets, or tv and video games. Pick something to do intentionally. We can forget that this evil continues to be present in our society, so take this day to remember, to pray, to work for an end to this great injustice. For the conversion of laws, culture, minds, and hearts. We pray for those who do not know, and especially for those who have been wounded by abortion. 


