FROM FR. QUINT

Our summer faith formation program began this past week and will continue into this week. We are grateful for those who serve as catechists and assist in forming the faith of these young people. I enjoy visiting their classrooms (sessions are held in our cluster elementary school, Xavier). The young children especially are attentive and eager to learn. I was speaking to the first graders about prayer. We considered how often we should pray, when we should pray, and how we should pray. I suggested that the sign of the cross might be the simplest prayer and a wonderful reminder of who God is and how he came to save us. St. Paul VI appreciated the value of the sign of the cross so much that he directed that Mass should begin with this sign of salvation.

Message from Haiti

To Father Quint and dear friends of Spires of Faith Cluster, greetings to you in the name of Jesus Christ,

Hoping that you are well with the grace of God. It is a pleasure to share these words with you on the life of the Holy Cross Parish of Fonds-Verrettes that you always support in these darkest moments of Haiti. You help us to hope, to keep the flame burning and still believe in life, despite everything. Thanks a lot!!!

CLINIC: Number at the clinic has decreased because people are investing in planting their crops. Lots of people are waiting at the Mobile Clinic in the chapel parishes. First-Aid kits are ready but other drugs are not. Impossible to get to Port-au-Prince because of the gangs, I try to buy them in Santo Domingo or Anse-a-Pitre (3h 18 min trip) but it is still very dangerous. Thanks to Spires of Faith Cluster for their \$3000.00 donation to help purchase these medications,

SCHOOL: Classes end June 2nd and exams begin the 3rd and end June 14th. School hopes to add the 12th grade next year. It will be difficult but with your support it can happen.

FOOD PROGRAM: Food Program office has called and has 90 bags of rice and 25 bags of beans but there is no way to reach Port-au-prince, gangs are in control. I have not been able to leave Fonds Verrettes, so we survive by buying products grown in the area and from the Dominican at exorbitant prices. The money you donated to Food for the Poor to increase our rice and beans allotment every two months, may be given directly to us so we can purchase more locally grown food for a more balanced diet. This will also promote national production and will help the farmers.

CHURCH: We had a collective marriage, with 9 couples. A beautiful celebration and reception for everyone all together. Sunday - May 29th was Mother's Day in Haiti. We had lots of fun. There was a program at Mass animated by the students, soccer tournament, a cultural part and music at the end. Happy Day for the Mothers. -- Father Lubermann
