***After a communication from the national office for liturgical matters, the order of our procession has been updated this year. The Blessed Sacrament will lead us along the route.*

THERMOSTATS ~ All of our cluster churches have programmable thermostats. When people push "HOLD" on the thermostats or REPROGRAM them, they fail in their purpose. Consultation regarding the programmed temperatures has been made not only with those who work with HVAC, but also with contractors who work with plaster, paint, glass and wood to assure that our investments in maintaining our churches will bear longstanding fruit. Humidity control in the summer is critical to preservation.

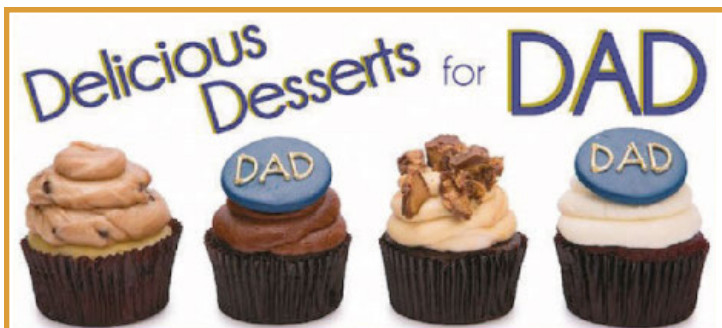

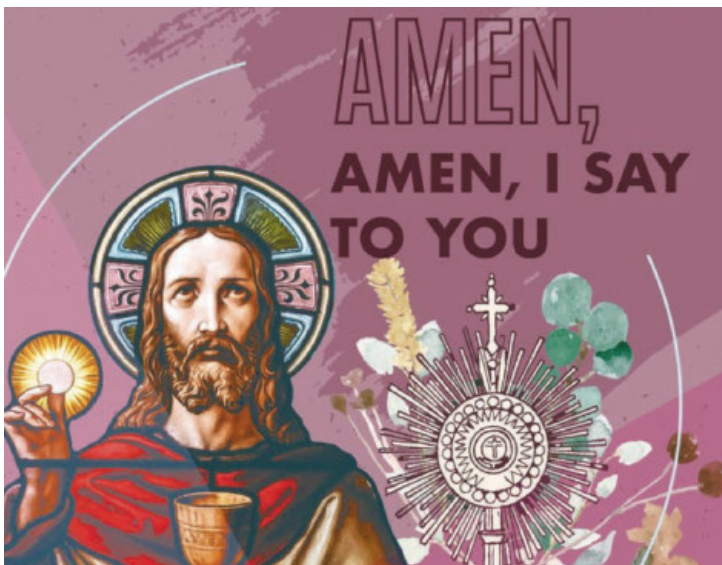
