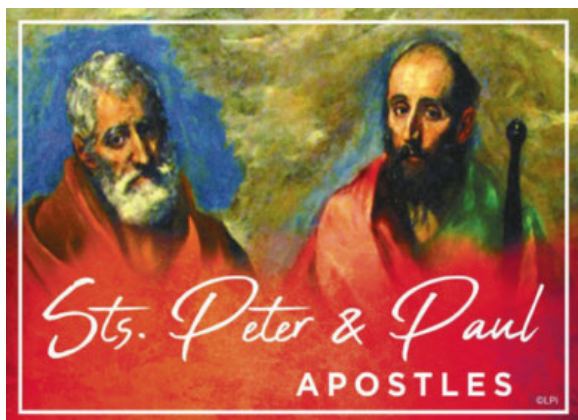

Synod Survey Report Available

You may recall the Archdiocesan Synod Survey that was put forward last February with regard to parish vitality and viability. Now a summary report has been posted on the archdiocesan website at www.dbqarch.org.

This report was sent to the United States Conference of Catholic Bishops and is the report for the archdiocesan family as well. The report summarizes the significant findings, conclusions and next steps in this work to build parish vibrancy.

Also posted are detailed summaries from each section of the survey (including short answer questions), focus groups and copy of the survey used. This information will provide further details and support for the significant findings and conclusions found in the Synod Survey Report. It will also provide much insight into what the nearly 16,000 participants feel.
