

MESSAGE FROM DEACON RIESBERG

My fellow parishioners and Clergy at the Spires of Faith Cluster, and all surrounding communities and citizens, I have shared most of my life in the best area of this country, with you, and plan to as long as the Lord allows. When God, in His infinite wisdom, decided to change my life 20 years ago, I was not prepared or ready to accept His decision. My wife of 30 years, Jean, was taken from this earthly life, leaving me to try to make it on my own. Again, God, in His infinite wisdom knew that was going to be a struggle. About 3 years later, Kathy became another blessing in my life, because her husband was also called from this world we live in.



A new journey began for us together. With 3 years of a program called Lay Formation (now called Impact), a very informative and insightful study of our Catholic faith, we felt a deeper calling, this time from the Lord himself. Kathy was instrumental in suggesting that I should apply to the Diaconate program for the Archdiocese of Dubuque. That began a 4 to 5 year application and formation process. With the help of the Holy Spirit, and many prayers from everyone in our communities, I was called to Ordination to be a Permanent Deacon for the Archdiocese of Dubuque on July 13, 2013. Wow! How life changes. Kathy and myself have had extreme life adjustments, mostly for the good, the rest even better, the best that life has to offer: OUR FAITH! With our Lord at the helm, we are in the boat (in our case-the RV), with Him, trusting that Thy Will Be Done.

I am certainly not perfect, I try not to offend anyone, and if I said something, or hurt anyone, please accept my sincere apologies. We as Catholic Christians are called to evangelize in words, actions and how we live. Our Churches, our Schools, our communities will be strong if we are together in WHO we are. We are the church. Our priests will always be vowed to the Archbishop, and have to move when asked, (or told). But we are the Parish, the Body Of Christ. Please be sure to continue to ask all Clergy if you have any questions and comments.

Serving the Spires of Faith Cluster as a Permanent Deacon for the last 9 years has been a Spiritual journey for myself and Kathy. The people we have met, the bonds we have built, the joys and sorrows we have shared, the ministry of faith sharing, and the Love of The Trinity has been very rewarding. Our love and joy of our ministries will continue to grow and will continue to be a part of everyone in our lives. Archbishop Jackels has granted me permission to retire from Active Diaconal duties from an official assignment, (because of the 75 birthdays that I have enjoyed), but I will retain my faculties so I can perform Diaconal duties as needed and are capable of doing, at the direction of our Pastor. As one of the workers in the vineyard, I answered God's call much later in life, but I would like to receive the same wage as those who answered God's call early in the day, and that's our eternal reward in heaven. I pray that all will join me in seeking the Lord with our whole hearts, our whole souls, and our whole minds. The Eucharist, in the form of Bread and Wine, is our life.
