MESSAGE FROM FR. PHILIP

My name is Fr. Philip Agyei, from Ghana in West Africa. I wish to be called simply as "Fr. Philip". I was born on October 27, 1978 in a humble countryside of about 30 families in Ghana called Hwidiem in Ashanti Region. I am from a big family of 9 - 4 girls and 5 boys. I am number five (middle child). I am blessed to have both parents alive. My father, James, is 85 and my mother, Cecilia, is 76 years of age.

After my Junior High School studies, I had the opportunity to attend Nsutaman Catholic High school for three years and post-secondary school at St. Hubert Seminary for one year for High



School and seminary formation, St. Paul's Seminary in Accra-Ghana for one year spirituality and three years of philosophical studies, St. Peter's Regional Seminary Cape Coast Ghana for four years of theological studies. I received Bachelor of Arts degree in Sociology and Religion from the University of Ghana-Legon, Bachelor of Arts in Theology from Pontifical Urban University Rome affiliates with St. Peters seminary and a Post Graduate Diploma in Education, Master's in Education guidance and counselling from the University of Cape Coast Ghana.

By God's grace, I was ordained a priest and incardinated into the Konongo-Mampong Diocese of Ghana on August 11, 2012. I would like you to join me in giving glory and praise to God for seeing me through and granting me all the needed graces to serve as a priest for 10 years. Following my priestly ordination 10 years ago, I have had the opportunity to serve the Church in different capacities as Associate Pastor for 3 years in St. Anthony's Parish at Ejisu, a teacher of Religious and Moral Education in Ejisu Roman Catholic Junior High School, and as a Pastor at St. Gabriel Parish at Asamang for 6 years. I served also as a chaplain, a teacher of Christian Religious Studies and a counselor at the Konadu Yiadom Catholic Senior High in my Diocese in Ghana.

Through the recommendation from Fr. Michael Hutchison and Fr. Paul Attah-Nsiah, priests from my Diocese in Ghana, who are serving in the Archdiocese of Dubuque, my Bishop, Joseph, gave me the permission to come and join them to serve in this Archdiocese. Since I arrived in the Archdiocese last year, I was assigned as Associate Pastor of Resurrection Parish in Dubuque. From July of 2022, about two weeks ago, I have taken up my second assignment in the Archdiocese as Associate Pastor in the Spires of Faith Cluster and currently residing in Earlville. Although I have been here for only two weeks, I would like to tell you how happy I am to be here with you and how much I have enjoyed your hospitality and affection so far. On behalf of my Pastor (Fr. Chris) and my brother Fr. Gabriel, also from Ghana, I would like to thank all of you for making us feel at home. God bless you!



MESSAGE FROM FR. CHRIS PODHAJSKY ~

My brothers and sisters in Christ of the Spires of Faith Cluster,

It is inspiring to see the dedication and devotion so many here have for the Mass and their churches. We are blessed with five beautiful spaces. It is sincerely an honor to celebrate with you in each one.

I am writing this to inform you of a tweak in how Masses will be done starting in August. Many of you already know that I have Celiac Sprue; this is an auto-immune condition that causes my immune system to attack myself in the presence of gluten. Low gluten presider hosts have already been distributed to the parishes for the Masses I celebrate.

This also means I'm more susceptible to other things. I have to constantly be on guard against sinus infections (which I can catch simply through exhaustion). And those who were present at my first weekend Mass on Saturday July 16th saw me come down with a nasty little 12 hour flu; it caused me to step out in the middle of Mass and Fr. Carl Ries to step in providentially. Thank God for Fr. Carl!

Basically, I have to watch my health a bit more than others. This brings me to the point of this letter. As a priest, I am obligated to purify the vessels at Mass. Purifying the chalices after many people have consumed from them only exposes me to one more potential source of bugs. (They have never offered the chalice at St. Mary's Hospital in Rochester for the same reason.) And so, starting in August, we will only distribute the Blessed Sacrament under the form of the hosts without the chalice.

I know this may disappoint some people. But it is always worth remembering that to even receive the tiniest particle of the Body of Christ, or drop of the Precious Blood, is to receive ALL of Christ's Body, Blood, Soul and Divinity. No one who receives in any way receives less. So to receive only with the host, is to receive ALL. No one is ever denied anything. The fullness of the Sacrament is in every particle of the Blessed Sacrament. It is part of the mystery of the Holy Eucharist.

We will adjust the schedules of the extra-ordinary Eucharistic ministers (whom we still very much need!). And if there are any questions, all are welcome to come and ask. I am here for everyone.

I thank you for your patience and assistance with my needs as I gladly serve so that God may fulfill your needs in abundance. Blessings in Christ.


