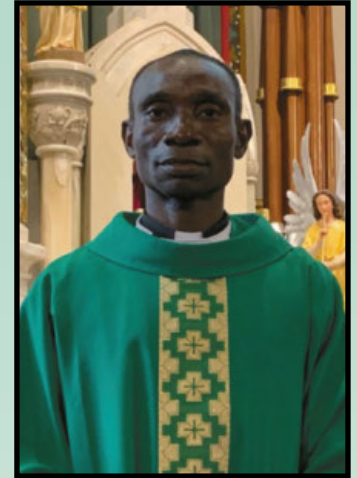

MESSAGE FROM FR. GABRIEL

Beloved in Christ of this our Noble Parish, Spires of Faith Cluster, may the peace of the Lord be with you all. I am Fr. Gabriel Oduro Mensah, an International Priest from the Archdiocese of Cape Coast, Ghana in West Africa. Last Friday, August 12th, 2022 was exactly two and half months since I arrived in the United States of America, specifically, IOWA. It was also a month since I took my appointment as an Associate Pastor in the Spires of Faith Cluster Parish. I am overwhelmed with the warm welcome accorded me by Fr. Christopher Podhajsky, Fr. Carl A Ries, Fr. Philip Agyei, the Rev. Deacons Roger, Keith, and Jim, the staff and all parishioners of the Spires of Faith Cluster. I am most grateful to you.



I was born on the 23rd of February 1968, at Abesewa Gyaman in the Wassa Amenfi East District in the Western of Ghana, to Mr. Gabriel Ekow Mensah (Deceased), from Denkyira Essikuma in the Central Region and Helena Quarshie of Abesewa Gyaman. From my mother's side, I am the eldest among five siblings of which three are males and two females, whereas from my father's side, am the fourth out of the 19 siblings; consisting of thirteen 13 males and six females.

I had my early childhood education at St. Mark's Catholic Kindergarten and Primary School from 1973-1978 at Abesewa Gyaman, while staying with my grandmother and the Upper Primary and Middle School Education at Denkyira Essikuma when I relocated to join my parents from 1979-1985.

I enrolled in St. Teresa's Minor Seminary Amisano, Elmina in October 1985 to begin my formation to the priesthood, and obtained my Ordinary Level and Advanced Level Certificates in 1991 and 1993 respectively, proceeded to St Paul's Seminary Sowutuom in Accra, the Capital City of Ghana for one year Spirituality and two years Philosophy from 1994 through 1996. I then furthered my studies and formation to the priesthood at St. Peter's Regional Seminary, Pedu in Cape Coast where I studied Theology and Sociology from 1997 to 1999. I did a year program called immersion, where I worked at Athena fruit Industry from September 1999 through September 2000. I finally went back to St. Peters Seminary, Pedu to complete my Seminary training and formation to the Priesthood from October 2000 to June 2001. I was ordained a priest on the 29th September 2001, the Feast Day of the Archangels; Gabriel, Michael and Raphael, at St. Francis De Salles Cathedral, by the then Archbishop of Cape Coast, Most Rev. Peter Kodwo Appiah Turkson, now Cardinal Peter Kodwo Appiah Turkson, Head of the Pontifical Academy of Sciences and the Pontifical Academy of Social Sciences.

I was appointed to Mary Immaculate Conception Parish, Anomabo as an Associate Pastor from November 2001 to February 2005. In February 2005 I was reassigned to St. Anthony's Rectorate at Twifo Hemang as the Rector, and later as the first Parish Priest when it was elevated to a Parish status in 2008. In October 2013, I was transferred to St. John the Baptist Rectorate, Akweley in Kasoa as the Rector. Then in February 2015 I was installed the First Parish Priest when it was raised to Parish status. In January this year I was transferred to St. Paul's Parish at Assin Jakai. Then in May I left Ghana for my new Pastoral Assignment here in the US.

My special thanks to the Archbishop, Most Rev. Michael E. Jackels, and Very Rev. Msgr. Thomas Taole, for accepting my offer to come and serve in this Archdiocese of Dubuque. I am also grateful to the immediate past Pastoral Director, Jeff Henderson, the current Pastoral Directress, Kim Hermsen, and Fr. Richmond DzeKoe for the tremendous support they gave me to get settle when I arrived. My in-depth gratitude goes to Fathers Quint, Tyler and Martin who prepared the place for my smooth takeover. I also owe Fr. Christopher Podhajsky, and the staff of the Spires of Faith Cluster Parish a deep appreciation for their thoughtfulness, love, and care. May the Lord fill you all with his peace.
