Message From Fr. Chris

Dear brothers and sisters in Christ,

Blessed, happy and holy Trinity Sunday! This is the weekend when we are called and able to celebrate the deepest and, in some ways, the most foreign mystery of the Faith. God in Himself is not a solitary, but a unity. God is radically and infinitely One and, at the exact same time, Three distinct persons. It is the mystery of the inner life of God expressed from a human perspective here on earth.

The underlying truth of this mystery is: we were made for this. We were made for communion with the ultimate Union that is God Himself. The seemingly limitless desires we experience, which have no final fulfillment here on earth, point to the infinite reality which will fill us to overflowing in heaven. Every human being has the capacity to receive the unimaginable, ever ancient and ever new Most Holy Trinity. When a person is made for God, it is no wonder that nothing on earth can truly satisfy.

The revelation of the Trinity, Three Persons in One God, without parts or divisions of any kind, is, in the truest sense, a mystery. Why did God reveal this to us now? He could have waited. I'm sure there will be many revelations about God when we enter eternity. Why reveal Himself in this way so difficult to comprehend?

The answer, to me, is based in love: God wants intimacy with each of us. To truly have interpersonal communion, we must reveal ourselves, one to another. And so, even though God's nature as God is so high above our understanding, He reveals His most personal (literally tri-personal) inner workings to invite us into communion with Himself. He does this first so that we might respond and reveal ourselves to Him. It is not that He doesn't know us, but to know about someone from the outside is very different than to have that person tell you about themselves. God tells us about Himself so that we might reveal ourselves, one on one, to Him.

This is oriented, as stated above, to interpersonal communion. This communion is exactly what happens at every Mass: an intimate exchange of persons. This is why, next week, we celebrate Corpus Christi; the Body of Christ given to unite the world in love. If you can, participate in the Corpus Christi procession (roughly 11:20 am start time at the Basilica). Even if you go to Mass at another time than 10:30 am, please come join the procession. Let us celebrate together the love of God in the Body of Christ, blessing the whole world.

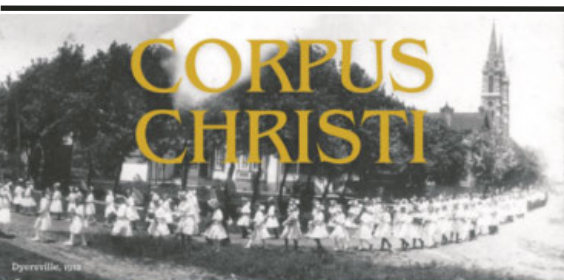
