Message From Fr. Chris

My brothers and sisters in Christ,

Happy Father's Day! There is something about fathers that the contemporary Western World has taken for granted. We know the numbers in terms of church attendance. If a father regularly goes to church, 33% of those children will go regularly as adults, with another 41% attending irregularly. If a father doesn't go to church, 2% will go regularly with 37% going irregularly. In other words, if dad goes to church, as adults 74% will participate in church to some degree, but if dad doesn't go, 61% will never darken the doorstep of the church building. That is a HUGE swing. It speaks to the massive impact that fathers have on their children spiritually and morally.

This isn't a matter of fathers having to be the leader in every spiritual activity. That certainly wasn't at all true in my family and I'm sure in many families, mothers take a spiritual lead. However, the above statistics show the spiritual impact of fathers' participation. It cannot be overstated. Many of us, because mom and dad simply went to church and supported us, may not have realized the effect our parents were having on us, individually and together. We have received so much from our mothers and fathers, gifts of earth and gifts of heaven, that we don't even realize it when we do. Just as we appreciated mothers in May, today is when we can appreciate our fathers for their love and sacrifices.

As we celebrate Father's Day, whether your dad is with you at home or has gone on to his eternal home, don't forget to offer some prayers for him and recommend his concerns and needs to God. Men need the spiritual support of God. God gives all of us hope; and we can trust God even when we don't know what to do. It is worth remembering that when God chose His primary name with which we are to invoke His love, His mercy, His forgiveness, and His help, He choose the name of "Father." It isn't that all dads are perfect, but God has called and used them to show His own love for us.
