Message From Fr. Chris

My brothers and sisters in Christ,

The month of October is the month of the Holy Rosary of the Blessed Virgin Mary. By tradition, it is said that St. Dominic (who put the Rosary together as we currently know it) and the early Dominicans received promises from the Blessed Virgin Mary to those who would devoutly and daily recite the Rosary. These are usually listed as the 15 promises made to those who pray the Rosary. I wanted to share these promises with you. The promises have born out through the course of time. Here are the first five.

1. Whoever shall faithfully serve me by the recitation of the Rosary, shall receive signal graces. *[A signal grace may be a simple sign in daily life that answers a question made in prayer or points towards God's will. For example, seeing a rose after finishing a novena to St. Therese of Lisieux could be considered a signal grace. Signal graces are often subtle or seemingly coincidental.]*
2. I promise my special protection and the greatest graces to all those who shall recite the Rosary.
3. The Rosary shall be a powerful armor against hell, it will destroy vice, decrease sin, and defeat heresies.
4. It will cause virtue and good works to flourish; it will obtain for souls the abundant mercy of God; it will withdraw the hearts of men from the love of the world and its vanities, and will lift them to the desire of eternal things. Oh, that souls would sanctify themselves by this means.
5. The soul which recommends itself to me by the recitation of the Rosary shall not perish. *[In other words, anyone who faithfully prays the Rosary and asks for Mary's intercession will not go to hell.]*

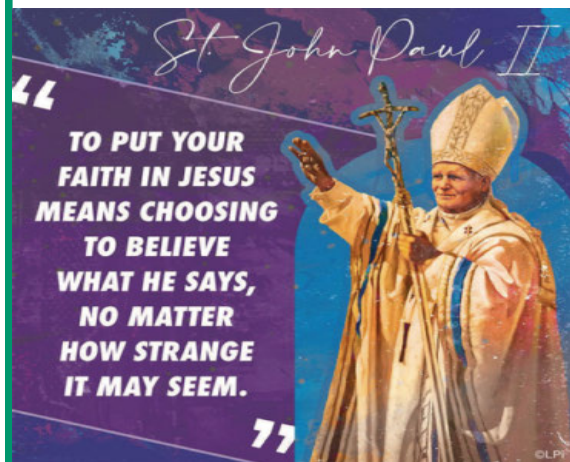
