

Grace of the Sacraments

This week we celebrate with our younger members of the community and their parents the blessings and the joys of the sacraments of Eucharist and Confirmation. As retired, Auxiliary Bishop Richard Sklba would remind folks: whenever a sacrament is celebrated, it is

not merely for the individual but for the whole church. As a result, I should more accurately say – the "whole church" celebrates with its younger members and their families the blessings of these sacraments of initiation.

The sacraments of Eucharist and Confirmation provide us opportunities not only to marvel how the Holy Spirit has made a difference in the lives of those who will receive them but also an opportunity to reflect on how the Holy Spirit has made a difference in our own lives through them. Think about how you have grown since you received your First Communion. Does the Eucharist continue to nourish you, is it life giving, does the mystery of the Lord's presence still bring you a sense of joy as it does these children? Yes, a lot has changed for most of us since second grade; however, it is still the same Lord present today that was present a long time ago. I encourage you to think about what has happened to

your faith since you were "sealed with the Holy Spirit." How has the Holy Spirit guided you through the joys and challenges that have been part of your life over the years? Have you been paying attention? The Spirit is always there, the problem is we too often live our lives with our hearts, ears and eyes closed and we miss the those "divine moments" when the Spirit is tugging at us!

The whole church may celebrate sacraments but it is now our responsibility to help these young folks discover what it means and will continue to mean to "be sealed with the Holy Spirit" and to receive the "Body of Christ." Those who have received the sacraments have not "finally finished" their formation but have merely begun to discover what is yet to be revealed by the loving God we believe it. The question is will we walk with them or have we given up what is yet to be discovered in our own lives – God has certainly not given up on us.

Huge thanks to all the staff members, catechists, teachers and especially parents\family members that have helped these young folks to reach these milestones. Continue to journey with them for there is so much yet to discover, for all of us.


