Do You Believe It?

As you recall, on the last weekend of November 2022, we celebrated the beginning of a new liturgical year (Year A – in case you are wondering) being reminded of all God has done for us and at the same time invited to prepare ourselves for the Second Coming by celebrating the first – Christmas. Surrounding this incredible feast of Christmas are numerous celebrations that point to its significance to the world and to our own individual lives. We gather to pray about and remember: The Holy Family, Epiphany, Baptism of the Lord, St. Stephen, St. John the Evangelist, Feast of the Holy Innocents and Mary: the Mother of God, to name but a few. All and so many more celebrations like these speak of the goodness of God and at times the cost of discipleship. Jesus more than anyone else showed us what it takes to believe in “God as Father.”

The temptation, my friends, is to celebrate these marvelous events and tenets of our faith as individual “moments” in history and forget to realize their meaning is centered in one singular belief; God’s infinite love for us and because of that love God will do everything possible to help us enter the Kingdom except force it

upon us. The above celebrations, taken individually, make nice stories, sell Christmas cards and make for great decorations but without the belief of God’s love are ultimately meaningless. Mary’s experience, the blessings of the Holy Family, the Feast of the Epiphany, the martyrdom of Stephen and the Holy Innocence and the Baptism of the Lord all speak of the divine hand of God working in our lives to open our hearts to the salvation Jesus won for us through His life, death and resurrection. Sadly, there are still too many people who believe God does not love them. That he plays with their lives to see if they are “worthy” of His love, hates them and punishes them for sins committed and/or is unable/unwilling to forgive their sins. Consequently, so many carry needless burdens because they cannot imagine a God that could love them that much, no matter who they are and the circumstances of their lives.

As we celebrate this Feast of Mary, the Mother of God may it be a reminder of God’s infinite love for us. May we see all God continues to do for us so we may join him in the Kingdom. May it also be an invitation to embrace more deeply that love, by embracing that love we come to experience, and know in our hearts “Immanuel” repeatedly as we enter this new year.

We Have Openings for Children in Our 3K Program: Holy Angels School offers a three day & five day K3 program as a pre-school opportunity. Both offer a half-day or full-day option. Requirements for children entering the three-year-old kindergarten are as follows:

- Age three (3) before September 1st
- Record of immunization
- Non-refundable first month's tuition and instructional fee
- An original birth certificate for recording information
- \$25.00 non-refundable registration fee
- Child must be toilet trained

Class size is usually limited to 16 students per session, with a classroom aide. A waiting list will be established when the class limit has been reached. The school reserves the option to increase the class size in order to accept all students on the waiting list as of August 1st. Registrations are accepted on a first-registered-first assigned basis. 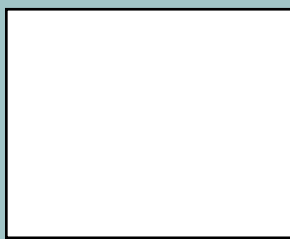

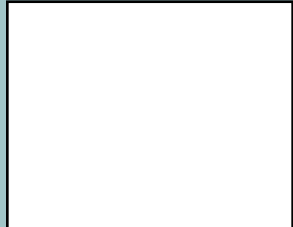

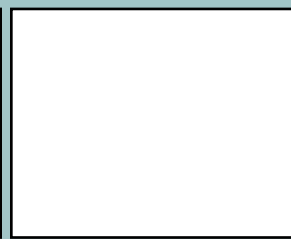
