I was recently asked "what are you planning to do for Lent?" Though it took me a little by surprise it was an excellent question and one I ought to have been thinking about as we quickly approach this sacred time – we are only one and a half weeks away from Ash Wednesday. One

may say "but we have plenty of time before we have to think about that, which is true; but the reality is we most likely won't think about it until we are sitting at mass for Ash Wednesday. We become so busy with so many things that we simply go from one project to the other and rarely give any of the projects the time they need and\or deserve. Believe me; I am not trying to place anyone on a "guilt trip." This is simply the reality of our lives and I include myself in this reality. In the "church world", it is easy for me to jump from one season to the next and miss the opportunity to reflect on how the Holy Spirit may have been speaking to my heart during a particularly sacred time such as Advent. There is the need for many of us, if not all of us, to slow down, be deliberate about our faith, and reflect on how the Lord may be inviting us to grow in faith through our words, example, family life and so much more. We have a lot of work to do.

This all brings me back to the question about Lent and what I was intending to do\or not do during that sacred time. A few things think about:

- Give the issue some time, after all time is one of the most precious commodities we have. Take a few moments, alone or with others and think about how you need to grow. The Spirit speaks - we need to listen.
- Be creative; this could be a family project that helps everyone
  be a little more kind, gentle, forgiving, understanding and
  generous to each other and those we encounter. Share with
  each other how this was shown in work, school and play. Adults
  share too! Maybe we share how we could have done better
  also
- Prayer, alms, fasting these cover a lot of area in the way we live do something!
- Work on a way and think about a way to hold yourself accountable. Lent is not a season about "pie in the sky theories," it is about the hard work of living and loving better. Metanoia is about change for the better, turning away from evil and embracing the good.
- Let the sign of "ashes" on our foreheads mean something.
- We have all sorts of resources available through the parish, take advantage – even a little bit – of what they have to offer.
   This sacred time really can make a difference in our lives if we

give the Holy Spirit a chance. Try not to let it take you by surprise this year.

#### **EDUCATION AND ACTIVITY CORNER**

**Sunday Connection:** Families have rules. Without rules, family life would be chaos. As a family, brainstorm a list of rules that you are all called to follow in your home in order for you all to get along together. Think about rules for play time, rules for eating, rules for how to speak to one another, rules for going out with friends, and so on. Emphasize that families follow rules as a way of showing love and respect for one another. Explain that in this Sunday's Gospel, Jesus talks about following the Law. Say: **God's Law of love can be thought of as rules that we are to follow in order to show our love and respect for one another.** Read aloud this Sunday's Gospel, Matthew 5:17–37. Talk specifically with one another about how anger is to be dealt with in your family. Conclude by praying for the grace to overcome anger and to show respect for one another as a family by following God's Law of love.






