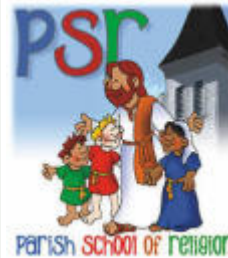
### Mass for Maintenance/Custodial Workers -

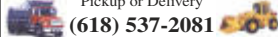
