

THE WISDOM OF BISHOP FULTON SHEEN

BROADMINDEDNESS, when it means indifference to right and wrong, eventually ends in a hatred of what is right.

WISDOM FROM THE SACRED SCRIPTURES

Wisdom from the Sacred Scriptures:

Sadly, people are not always truthful—they lie. Lying breaks down the fundamental bonds of trust that unite us. Lying is opposed to truth; and it is an offense against justice, since we owe other's the truth. King Saul lies in order to deceive David when he responds to David's protestations of innocence with an apparent confession: "I have done wrong; return, my son David, for I will no more do you harm" (1Sam26:21). Saul has proven himself false repeatedly, and as a result his promises of peaceful welcome cannot be trusted. Indeed, we find Saul giving David's wife to another man (see 1Sam. 25:44).

In the trial of Jesus, Pilate pronounces the verdict three times: not guilty (see LK 23:14, 15, 22). Jesus is innocent, and Pilate knows this to be true. Yet the Roman governor does not have the will to back up his truthful words with right action in the face of Jesus's accusers. Despite the "not guilty" verdict, Pilate sentences Jesus to death. The punishment does not fit the "crime," nor even the judge's own verdict! Proverbs reminds us, "Lying lips are an abomination to the LORD, but those who act faithfully are his delight" (Proverbs 12:22). What can you do to grown in the virtue of honest—in word and deed?
