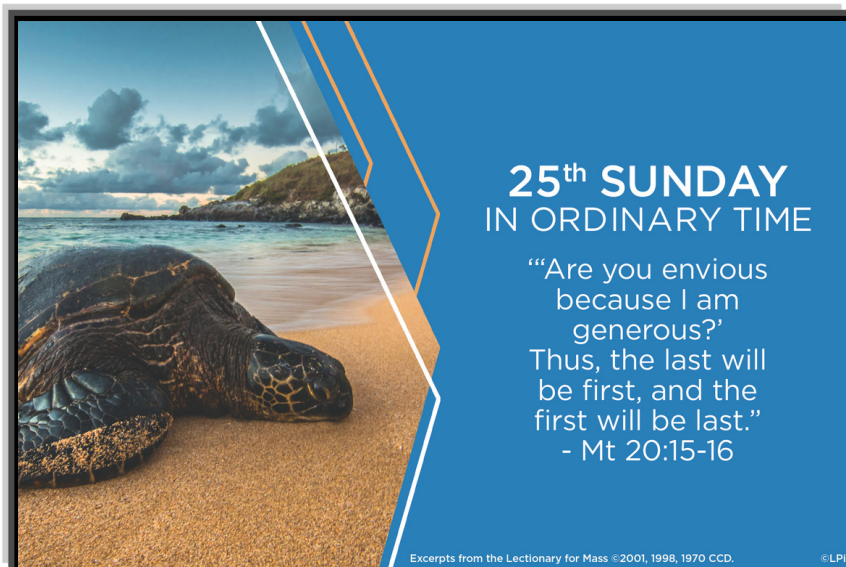

THE BEATIFICATION OF FULTON SHEEN

Archbishop Fulton Sheen is scheduled to be beatified this Thursday, September 24th in St. Louis, Missouri. Sheen was a pioneer in religious broadcasting, hosting the radio show "The Catholic Hour" from 1930 to 1950. He then hosted the groundbreaking television program "Life is Worth Living" from 1952 to 1957, which at its peak drew up to 30 million viewers every week. EWTN will be broadcasting live on Thursday starting at 8:00am, with the Beatification beginning at 1:00pm.

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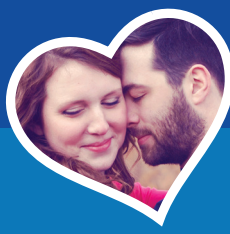
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
