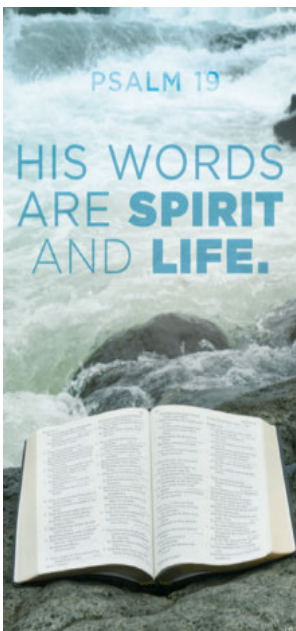

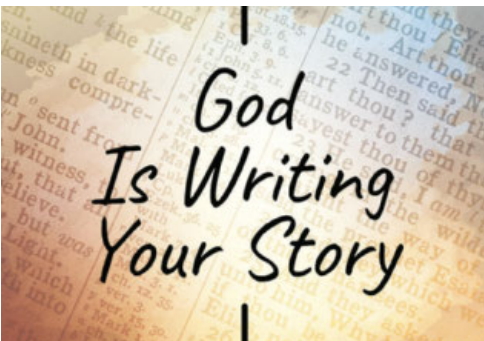

Candlemas

Wednesday, February 2nd at 8:30 am

This feast marks the occasion when, according to Jewish custom, the Blessed Mother and St. Joseph brought baby Jesus to the temple in Jerusalem forty days after His birth to offer a sacrifice of thanksgiving and to dedicate Him to Lord (Luke 2:22-40).

You are welcome to bring candles to Mass on Wednesday so they may be blessed for use in your home. Many like to burn a candle when praying at home. A blessed candle is a sacramental, an object that can arouse and sustain within us faith and devotion.





The Word of Life

Catholics are often criticized for not knowing the Bible. The irony is, at every Sunday Mass, we listen to three different readings from the Bible, plus a Psalm. But many Catholics feel unprepared when it comes to explaining and defending our teachings from the Scriptures. There is a solution for such feelings: become familiar with the Bible! We are so blessed to be the recipients of divine revelation in the Scriptures. In fact, the Bible is the Word of Life. It is like no other work of literature, for it is a living Word; whenever we read it, God Himself is speaking to us. We can hear a message from God anytime we desire, simply by opening the Bible.

For us Catholics, the Bible is three things: it is our history, our instruction for life, and an encounter with Jesus Christ. In recent years there has been an increased interest in discovering our roots, whether through our communal history, or through our genetic makeup. We want to know who we are, and where we came from. Only then do we know where we are going. The Bible is our history, going all the way back to the first human beings. And while much of the Old Testament seems difficult to us, because it speaks of ancient, Hebrew culture, nevertheless, the Bible is our history, because it is “salvation history.” The Bible tells of God’s love and concern for His human children, and His desire that we reach our eternal destination in the Heavenly Kingdom. So, we need to know the characters of Scripture, for they are our ancestors in the faith. It is sad if we do not know who Abraham and Sarah were, or if we don’t know why David was important, or if we are unfamiliar with the writings of the Prophets.

Studying the Bible for a historical understanding is important, and throughout the year, there are many opportunities for Bible study here at St. Barnabas. But studying the historical context of Scripture is only part of the purpose of these Holy Books. The Scriptures are also a divine code of conduct, teaching us how to live our lives morally in a way which pleases God, and allow us to grow in holiness. The books of the Bible are the directions for life. If we seek peace, and success, and happiness, we can turn to the Bible for instruction. Our first reading tells of the return of the people of Israel from their long exile in a foreign land. For decades, they had no access to the Sacred Scriptures. On this occasion, Ezra the priest read from the Scriptures to the people, explaining the meaning as he went. The people wept, because they had lived so long without divine instruction. They realized that the Holy Books were their identity as a people, and they had been lost without them. We should never take the Bible for granted; it is God’s gift to us.

Study of the Bible, and being instructed by it are truly important. But the most important reason to know the Bible is because it reveals Jesus Christ to us. Truly, we see and touch Jesus in the flesh in the Eucharist. But the Bible is also an encounter with our Lord. St. Jerome, an early scholar of Sacred Scripture, once said, “Ignorance of Scripture is ignorance of Jesus Christ!” At the beginning of His ministry, Jesus entered the synagogue at Nazareth. He received the scroll of the Prophet Isaiah, and read the passage which says, *“The Spirit of the Lord is upon me, because he has anointed me to bring glad tidings to the poor. He has sent me to proclaim liberty to captives and recovery of sight to the blind, to let the oppressed go free, and to proclaim a year acceptable to the Lord.”* Then Jesus declared, “Today this Scripture is fulfilled.” It was fulfilled because it told of Jesus, and now He stood before them in the flesh.

Whenever we open the Bible, we have an encounter with Jesus Christ. So, may we each continue to become more familiar with the Bible, so that we might know who we are, where we’ve come from, where we’re going, and how to get there. And let’s open the Bible every day, so we can encounter Jesus Christ, the Word of Life.

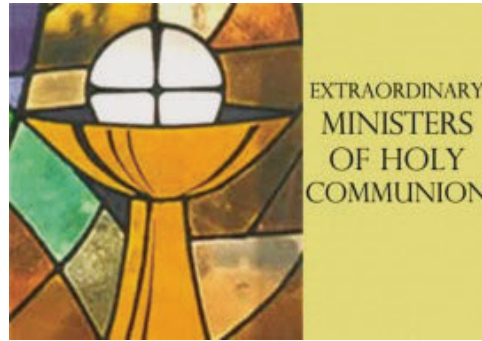
