


Holy Communion in Parking Lot to be Discontinued

Who Am I?

In last week's Old Testament reading, Moses asked God's name. In response, God introduced Himself as, "I AM." In light of knowing God as I AM, the next question we ask is, "Who am I?" We spend most of our lives seeking the answer to that question. Along the way we try on different identities and roles, and we spend tremendous amounts of energy projecting false images of ourselves to others. Just as Lent is a time for removing insufficient labels from God, that we might know Him in truth, so it is a season for peeling off many of the false labels we have placed on ourselves.

So, who am I? Am I what people think of me? Am I what I think of myself? Am I playing a role, or many roles, which sacrifice my personal integrity? Am I the sum of my life's experiences? Am I defined by my history, or by my present circumstances in life? As I reflect on my need for grace during this season of Lent, am I defined by my sins? Am I a "sinner," or am I "someone" who sins? What is the difference? If I say I am a sinner, then I am defined essentially by my sins. But if I am "someone" who sins, then sin does not define who I am; instead, sins are my wayward actions, things which are not essential to my being. So, who is the one who sins? Who am I?

Perhaps we should find out who God says we are. God says we are His beloved children. He loves us so much that He sent His Son as a remedy for our sins. Jesus came to seek and to save the lost. Most of us feel lost much of the time because sin confuses us, disorients us, and causes us to reject God and His ways. Sin deceives us as to our own identity; we could say that when we sin, we are not ourselves. We even begin to doubt God's love for us; we become suspicious, and believe that God is out to get us, just looking for a reason to condemn us in our sins. Sin separates us from God and destroys us, and that is why God hates all sin. We are God's beloved children, but sin prevents us from realizing that is who we are.


In today's Gospel reading, Jesus tells the story of a son who chased after harmful things which he believed would bring him happiness. He demanded from his father his share of the estate, and then left home to pursue his worldly desires. He did not realize, until much later, that his greatest treasure and happiness were to be found in his father's love for him: the very love he tossed aside. After a short while, the young man was out of money, and reduced to a pitiful state. The Scripture says, "Having come to himself," he decided to return home to his father. The Greek word for "penance" is metanoia, meaning, to come to our senses, or to become ourselves again. To repent is to wake up to who we truly are in God's sight.

But the young man still had something to learn about himself and about his father. Projecting his own callousness and pettiness onto his father, he expected to be treated only as one of the servants upon his return home. But the father far exceeded his expectations: he ran down the road to meet his son, welcomed him with tears of joy, and received him as his own dearly beloved son. Only now did the young man realize who he truly was all along. He truly was the son of his father, but only now did he know the depths of his father's love for him. Then there was a huge celebration, for having "come to himself," the son had come home!

But the older brother was angry, and jealous. He told his father, "I served you faithfully all these years, and you never gave me a celebration." The older brother also needed to come to himself, for he had been playing the role of a servant, rather than living as a son. He had also underestimated his father's love for him. So, his father told him, "All I have is yours... and it always was, and always will be!" And he helped his son better to understand his role as an older brother, saying, "Your brother was dead, and is alive again! He was lost, and now is found!" In fact, both of them were "found," for they found their true identities in light of their father's love.

By His life, death, and resurrection, Jesus reveals to us that we are children of the Father, the great I AM. So, when confronted with the question, "Who am I," the answer is, "I am a child of I AM!"



Playing the 50/50 Drawing








July 2022 Bishop Bruté Days

St. Anthony of Padua Parish in MORRIS, IN

St. Anthony of Padua parish in MORRIS, IN is a small parish in SE Indiana, founded in 1856, and has only 297 families. But this little parish has had a BIG impact in the town of Gandou, Haiti. Their goal is 'to provide health care, food education and love to ease the suffering and to strengthen the poorest people of Haiti with the purpose of leading them to the point that they can care for themselves and become self sufficient.'

The Gandou community has no access to medical care beyond the services this ministry provides, and Gandou is a 5 to 6 hour walk to other medical care. Since 2006, the St. Anthony's/St. Louis' Haiti Ministry has completed twenty-six medical mission trips to Gandou. The most recent trip was in March, 2021, during which 937 patients were seen by the visiting medical staff with many more seeking care.

In June, 2021, the ministry hired a doctor who is now in Gandou five days a week, joining the nurses which the ministry employs. In addition to addressing acute patient needs, the doctor and staff run programs focused on child malnourishment, high blood pressure and diabetes. The ministry has also trained midwives to serve the community.

Recently the Haiti Ministry team submitted a request to our Outreach Ministry to assist with building a clinic for the medical personnel to work from. Through your stewardship to St. Barnabas we were able to assist with their building program and participate in a matching funds opportunity to double our support!

Through YOUR generosity we are able to touch the lives of those living in poverty in Haiti. A recent thank you note from the mission team states:

"The clinic will not only provide a place where the poor will receive medical care in dignity, but it is also a symbol of God's love for them made tangible by the love and generosity of people like you. Thank you for bringing hope to the poor and hopeless."






