

Hiding Jesus

The Fifth Sunday of Lent begins what we call "Passiontide," the final two weeks of Lent leading up to the Sacred Triduum of Holy Thursday, Good Friday, and Easter. Traditionally, churches would cover crosses and images of Saints during Passiontide. But why? There are two explanations. One comes from John, chapter 8, which tells of the rejection of Jesus by the people. Not only did they reject Jesus, but they also tried to stone Him. So, Jesus had to hide Himself from them (Jn. 8:59). The second explanation for covering sacred images during Passiontide is that throughout His suffering, the divinity of Jesus was hidden from the people.

We might associate the hiding of Jesus with His Ascension into Heaven. By ascending, He was taken from our sight, and from the sight of the world. But Jesus came to reveal the Father to the world: why, then, does He seem to hide Himself? Jesus hides Himself so that He might be revealed in us, His Church. Jesus fills us with His own life in baptism, and sends us to be light for the world. Are we fulfilling our mission? Or, are we hiding Jesus? It isn't easy for us to admit that we may be hiding Jesus, and most of the time we're unaware that we're doing so. And often, we do more than hide Jesus: sometimes we actually reject Him, and drive Him from our lives.


How might we be hiding, or rejecting Jesus? We reject Jesus when we sin. No matter how small the sin may be, it requires us to reject Jesus if only for a moment. We may even find ourselves choosing sin over Jesus, as we excuse ourselves or try to justify our choices. Even if we are not consciously rejecting Jesus, we hide Him when we fail to bring light to the world by actively living as His disciples. Or, maybe we're ashamed of our faith before others, and shrink from witnessing to Jesus out of preference for being accepted by society. For some, the life of faith is simply not that important to them, or perhaps is seen as irrelevant to real life. Such people do not identify themselves with Jesus or with their Catholic faith.

So, how do we stop hiding and rejecting Jesus? How do we unveil Him for the world to see? We find the answer in today's Gospel reading. After the crowd had departed, having been convicted of their own sins, Jesus says to the woman who had been caught in adultery, "Go, and sin no more." He is not just scolding her, and saying, "Now don't do that again!" Jesus knows that she cannot avoid sin on her own. When Jesus says to her, and to us, "Go, and sin no more," He is empowering us to become holy. Jesus' command is greater than just avoiding sin; His command is to go and reveal Him to the world through a life of holiness. For when the veils of sin are stripped away in our lives, Jesus is revealed and His light shines clearly for all to see.

The unveiling of Jesus in our lives means a new way of life, and a way forward. It means putting away those things which bind us and hold us back, while following Jesus in a new way. In our first reading today, God says, "Remember not the events of the past, the things of long ago consider not; see, I am doing something new!" In our second reading, Paul puts it this way, "Forgetting what lies behind but straining forward to what lies ahead, I continue my pursuit toward the goal, the prize of God's upward calling, in Christ Jesus." The world is in so much darkness and is dying to see the light of Jesus. The world needs the hope which only we, the Church of Jesus, can give. But we cannot give what we ourselves do not possess.

We need a plan for Passiontide. So, here is a spiritual exercise we each can employ. Find a quiet place for prayer, sit down, and relax. Say to Jesus, "Here I am, Lord. I want to talk to you about my life." Then, describe to Jesus what you would look like as a Saint. What veils, which have been hiding Jesus, need to be set aside? What activities and attitudes need to be taken up to cause His light to shine brightly in your life? See yourself living as a Saint in daily life, in your work and in your relationships. Ask Jesus to give you the grace to become that Saint. Ask Jesus to help you know how grace is active in your life, and to help you put aside sinful habits. We can only remove the veils in our lives by first knowing how, and why, we are hiding Jesus.

Anyone who is interested in joining the Lector Ministry is welcome to attend.








Gt. Barnabas Religious Vocation!

St. Anthony of Padua Parish in MORRIS, IN

St. Anthony of Padua parish in MORRIS, IN is a small parish in SE Indiana, founded in 1856, and has only 297 families. But this little parish has had a BIG impact in the town of Gandou, Haiti. Their goal is 'to provide health care, food education and love to ease the suffering and to strengthen the poorest people of Haiti with the purpose of leading them to the point that they can care for themselves and become self sufficient.'

The Gandou community has no access to medical care beyond the services this ministry provides, and Gandou is a 5 to 6 hour walk to other medical care. Since 2006, the St. Anthony's/St. Louis' Haiti Ministry has completed twenty-six medical mission trips to Gandou. The most recent trip was in March, 2021, during which 937 patients were seen by the visiting medical staff with many more seeking care.

In June, 2021, the ministry hired a doctor who is now in Gandou five days a week, joining the nurses which the ministry employs. In addition to addressing acute patient needs, the doctor and staff run programs focused on child malnourishment, high blood pressure and diabetes. The ministry has also trained midwives to serve the community.

Recently the Haiti Ministry team submitted a request to our Outreach Ministry to assist with building a clinic for the medical personnel to work from. Through your stewardship to St. Barnabas we were able to assist with their building program and participate in a matching funds opportunity to double our support!

Through YOUR generosity we are able to touch the lives of those living in poverty in Haiti. A recent thank you note from the mission team states:

"The clinic will not only provide a place where the poor will receive medical care in dignity, but it is also a symbol of God's love for them made tangible by the love and generosity of people like you. Thank you for bringing hope to the poor and hopeless."




