



Fear and Doubt

Three times in today's Gospel reading Jesus says, "Peace be with you." Jesus wants us to have peace in our souls, but most of the time we are not truly at peace. That lack of peace gnaws at us inside, causing us to be restless, and to behave in strange ways. Most of life's problems arise from two sources: fear, and doubt. When we doubt God's existence, we find limited meaning in our own. This lack of meaning in our lives causes us to go in search of something to make us feel we have some value within ourselves. When we do believe in God, but doubt His love for us, we live in constant fear of Him. But Jesus wants us to have peace. And this peace can come to us in the midst of our fear and doubt. In fact, these are the very places where Jesus comes to meet us, to say to us, "Peace be with you!"

On that first Easter evening, the Apostles were hiding behind locked doors, out of fear that what had happened to Jesus would also happen to them. They did not yet believe that Jesus had arisen from the tomb; for them, Jesus was dead. Yet, in spite of the locked doors, Jesus entered into their midst, saying, "Peace be with you." Once they witnessed their risen Lord, they rejoiced. A second time, Jesus said, "Peace be with you," as He declared that He was sending them out into the world, just as the Father had sent Him. By this, the Apostles found their purpose. They had been fishermen, and tax collectors, but now they realized their higher calling: to bring peace to the world by proclaiming God's love in Jesus Christ. Then, Jesus breathed the Spirit on them. This giving of the Spirit was for the authority to forgive sins; later, on Pentecost, they would receive the power of the Spirit to become missionaries.

Thomas was not with the other Apostles when Jesus came to them alive. When he returned, Thomas refused to accept their joyful testimony. He doubted, and in his doubt placed conditions on his belief in the resurrection of Jesus. He declared that he would not believe until he saw Jesus with his own eyes, and touched the nail and spear marks in Jesus' body. A week later, Jesus came again into the locked room, and said, "Peace be with you!" Then, He told Thomas to touch the marks in His body, as He admonished him for his refusal to believe the testimony of his brothers.


There is something very fascinating here to which we must give our attention. Thomas placed restrictions on his belief in Jesus' resurrection. What Thomas wanted proof of is that the man, Jesus of Nazareth, had risen from the dead. Thomas knew that dead people simply do not rise from the grave. But Thomas' encounter with the risen Jesus took him to a greater experience: upon seeing Jesus, and touching Him, Thomas did not say, "You fellows were right: the man, Jesus, our teacher, is alive again." No, Thomas was seeing more than a dead man alive again. Thomas declared, "My Lord, and my God!" Thomas came to a new understanding that Jesus was in fact God made flesh. Now, he would have a truly profound and supernatural peace in his soul.


Although Jesus had appeared to the Apostles a week earlier, on that second Sunday they were still behind locked doors. And, even after Jesus' second visit, the Apostles were not yet ready to go out and evangelize. They were still growing in God's grace, and working through their fear. Only weeks later, after receiving the Holy Spirit, were they equipped to leave their room and go out to proclaim the resurrection to the world. On that occasion, they had been praying together in the upper room, preparing themselves for the mission Jesus would give them.

Jesus comes to us when we are locked away within ourselves due to fear and doubt. In fact, Jesus uses fear and doubt to cause our faith to grow. As our faith grows, so does our peace. Let Jesus meet you in your fear and doubt. Say to Him, "Jesus, I'm afraid, and I feel locked away in my fear. Jesus, I doubt, but I want to believe. Jesus, I want to know you, and to have peace." Jesus always knows where to find us, and He can even come into our locked rooms. When He comes, all we must do is to accept Him, on His terms. When He comes, He takes us beyond our expectations to experience Him in ways beyond our comprehension. Today, simply say to Jesus, "Here I am, Lord. Here I am in my doubts, my fear, my confusion." There, Jesus will come and say, "Peace be with you. I am here for you, even in your fear and doubt."



As part of our Outreach Ministry team meetings we are discussing the **Principles of Catholic Social Teaching**, and how we are promoting those teachings here at St. Barnabas. Recently we discussed **Care for God's Creation**.

Pope Francis tells us that "Everything is connected. Concern for the environment thus needs to be joined to a sincere love for our fellow human beings and an unwavering commitment to resolving the problems of society."

At St. Barnabas we offer recycling opportunities for our parishioners. In the front parking lot there are 2 bins for paper recycling. That includes; newspapers, magazines, office/school paper, sales catalogs and mail. These bins **DO NOT take phone books or cardboard**.

Also in the front parking lot is the St. Vincent de Paul clothing bin. This bin accepts SOFT goods; clothing, shoes, linens, blankets etc. **NOTHING BREAKABLE**. These items are given to the families served by SVdP or may be sold at the Mission 27 shop to support SVdP programs.

In the back lot is a recycle bin for aluminum cans. They DO NOT TAKE GLASS OR PLASTIC.

Please take advantage of these opportunities to make use of items that you no longer want or need. Pope Benedict XVI tells us "we must recognize our grave duty to hand the earth on to future generations in such a condition that they too can worthily inhabit it and continue to cultivate it." Recycling is just one small way to protect our earth for future generations.
