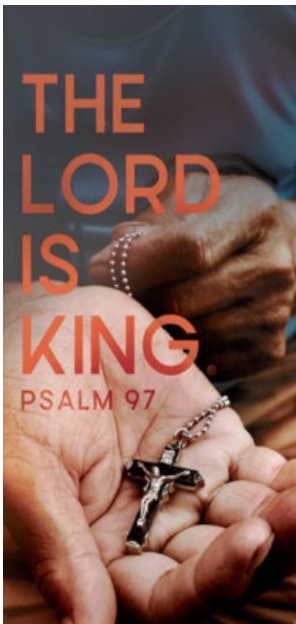

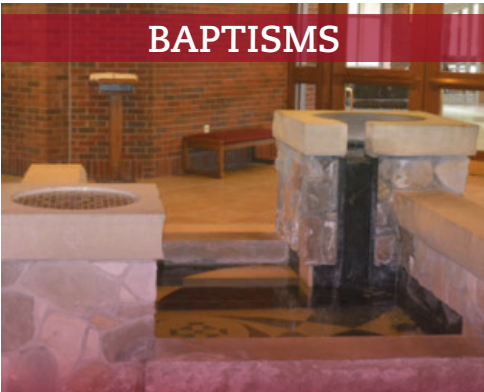
Parish Picture Directory Update

A Higher Purpose

On the first Easter morning, Mary Magdalene was overcome with joy when she saw Jesus alive. She wanted to hold onto Him, and never let Him out of her sight. But Jesus said to her, “Do not cling to me, for I have not yet ascended to my Father.” Instead of trying to keep Jesus in this world, Mary was given a mission: to go and tell others the good news that Jesus had risen from the dead. By our baptism into the death and resurrection of Jesus, all of life is consecrated for us. Everything we do should be considered sacred, and a way of proclaiming Jesus risen from the dead. Everything for us in this life has a higher purpose.

Most of the evil in this world is due to not recognizing the higher purpose of all things. When we only focus on the wealth and resources of this world, we realize there is scarcity. So, we become selfish, seeing others as competing for the same limited resources, and as obstacles standing between us and our own comfort. If we live only for life in this world, we must also try to find meaning for our lives by exalting ourselves over others, fighting for our fifteen minutes of fame. If there is no higher purpose to life, we become a godless, and dangerous people.

Or, we may be a religious people, who only use religion as a way of navigating life in this world. We find the teachings of Jesus helpful for living as good citizens and as a way to live peacefully with one another. We cling to Jesus, as Mary Magdalene did, in an attempt to find temporal comfort and blessing. But Jesus told Mary, “I must go to my Father, and to your Father; to my God and your God.” By this, Jesus was teaching Mary, and us, that where He has gone, we are called to follow. This Feast of the Ascension calls us to keep our hearts and minds lifted up to God in all things, that we might discover life’s higher purpose. This is the prayer of St. Paul for the Church, as found in our second reading: “May the God of our Lord Jesus Christ, the Father of glory, give you a Spirit of wisdom and revelation resulting in knowledge of Him. May the eyes of your hearts be enlightened, that you may know what is the hope that belongs to His call, what are the riches of glory.”

So then, by God’s grace within us, let us open the eyes of our hearts and see the higher purpose in all things. We each are sons and daughters of God, called to make God visible in the flesh. In that sense, we are each a Christ. The work we do, whatever it is, is the work of God. We are made holy in baptism, and so our work becomes holy because we are doing it. But, this requires constant awareness that everything we do has a higher purpose. Through our work, we are being formed as saints. Marriage is not just a civil contract; marriage is a covenant, and a Sacrament of Christ’s love for His Bride, the Church. Married couples make this love visible, and so marriage has a higher purpose. By offering themselves as Christ for one another, husbands and wives become saints. The family is a sign of the family of God gathered safely into the Kingdom of Heaven. And, while family life has its challenges, it is called the “school of Christ,” where each member learns to love and serve the others, becoming more like Christ.

St. Barnabas is known for sports. Even playing a sport has a higher purpose. The point of a sport should not be merely to win and defeat others. One’s greatest opponent is oneself. The goal of sports is to challenge ourselves to be our best. If someone outperforms us, in humility we appreciate their skills, and humbly learn from our defeats. God’s intended purpose for every human activity is that it forms us in the image of His Son. And, by imitating Jesus in all things, seeing a higher purpose, we realize that at the end of this life, we also will ascend to the Kingdom Jesus has gone to claim for us.

While still in this world, we ascend by lifting up our hearts and minds to God at every moment. As a reminder, I’m asking everyone to focus on three ways we can do this daily. First, by praying as individuals, as families, and as a parish. Second, by continuing to be formed in the faith by learning something new each day from the Scriptures, books, or even electronic media. Third, by engaging in acts of love and service for others. In these ways the eyes of our hearts are enlightened, and we honor our risen and ascended Lord by keeping in heart and mind life’s higher purpose.

Dear CYO & CYO Camp Family Member,

Once again, we want to thank you for your kind, generous, and loyal support of CYO over the years. Periodically, we send out a message to our large list of CYO family members, especially when there is a need at CYO/Camp that needs to be shared. This is one of those times.

In large part because of where our economy is at this time, **we are very much struggling with finding enough counselors for CYO Camp this summer... especially with male counselors!!** Many of our college-age counselors are finding jobs that in years past might not be available during the summer. However, with many small businesses begging for help so they might keep their doors open, some who would have been counselors in the past are going in a different direction this summer. **At this time we have a list of almost 200 young campers who are now on a waiting list because we do not have enough counselors to accommodate them... and the majority of these are boys because of our male counselor shortage!!**

Therefore, if you know of someone (male or female) who is a recent high school graduate, or is in the 18 - 24 age range who enjoys working with kids, please share this message with them. **Please also share that this is a paid position, offering up to 9 weeks of paid employment this summer!!** Having attended camp in the past might be helpful, as they would be familiar with how impactful the camp experience continues to be for so many, however, this is not required. College students who are pursuing a degree in Education typically are a logical fit, as are anyone who has worked with children in the past. However, if you know someone who is looking for a summer job that is fun, exciting, rewarding and has the added bonus of working with kids in a fun environment, this could be that perfect opportunity to be a part of an amazing summer experience!

If you know of a young person who you think might be interested in spending the summer working with kids, please pass this info on to them. **Again, this is a paid position, offering up to 9 weeks of paid employment this summer!** If interested, they can go to the CYO Camp website at

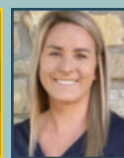
