Volunteer Spotlight



Growing up in Door County, Fish Creek, was a hoot great summers and long winters. Sandi, my wife, grew up in Egg Harbor, six miles south. So yeh, we pretty much knew each other since the mid 50s when the nuns would host two weeks of catechism every summer at Egg Harbor Grade School just up the hill from Saint John's Catholic Church. We are proud graduates of Gibraltar High graduating in a class of 65 in 1965. After a couple years at UW Madison, I joined the Air Force in 1968. In September of that year, Sandi and I married at Saint John's when I was on leave from USAF Tech School in Biloxi, Mississippi, From Tech School, I was assigned to duty in the Security Service Arm of the Air Force for two years at Misawa Air Base in Japan. Sandi flew over a couple months after our wedding and we lived off base in Misawa until I was reassigned to Clark

Air Base in the Philippines 15 months later.

After four years in the Air Force, I attended radio school in Minneapolis. After radio gigs in Austin, MN, Sturgeon Bay and La Crosse, WI and Burlington, IA, we finally planted roots in Appleton in May of 1983 when I joined Woodward Radio, which in those days was known just as WHBY-Am and WAPL-FM. 
