

### St. Anthony Can Find Anything — Even You



“Tony, Tony, come around! Something is lost and it must be found.”

Did you learn this one when you were a kid? In my experience there are even a lot of lapsed Catholics — or people who were never Catholic at all — who know that when you lose something, St. Anthony becomes your best friend. Missing keys? Pray to St. Anthony. Can't find your favorite sweater? St. Anthony. Forget where you parked your car in the mall lot? St. Anth— okay, you get the idea. Whatever it is, large or small, important or trivial, Tony has a reputation for finding the lost things.

It's a devotion that can seem a little like superstition — witchcraft, even? — if you don't really understand it. Mumble an incantation to a dead guy and you're guaranteed to find your sunglasses. But as with most traditions that are old, beloved and effective, looking a little closer reveals the truth of the matter.

When we lose something really important, what do we do? We make the whole household stop what they're doing to join the search. Having St. Anthony as a friend means you ask him to stop what he's doing to help, too. And how he helps is by taking the matter exactly where all matters need to go — straight to the feet of Christ.

Here's the real genius of St Anthony: he takes the most mundane, commonplace occurrence — misplacing socks — into an encounter with the divine and truly all things great and small are gifts from God. He grabs our hand and points to the cross. “That's what you're looking for,” he tells us.

In the end, Tony doesn't really find the lost things. He finds the lost people.

## PROVIDENCE NEVER FAILS

Dear Parishioners,

This weekend the dispensation from our serious obligation to attend Mass each Sunday has been discontinued. Beginning this weekend, all Catholics are obligated to attend Mass unless they have a good reason for not doing so. This is nothing new.

Those who for no good reason skip Mass are no longer in the State of Grace and should make a sacramental confession before approaching Holy Communion. This idea of an unworthy reception of Holy Communion (based in the writings of Saint Paul among other places) is in the news quite a bit these days. This is mainly because of so-called “Catholic” politicians and government leaders who publicly promote and oppose Catholic teachings on a variety of issues.

But this notion of a “sacrilegious Communion” is not limited to public figures. It applies to all of us. The bottom line is that someone who is not in good standing in the Church should not receive Holy Communion until the situation has been rectified.

Now, at the same time, there are valid reasons for having to miss Mass on the weekend. Prominent among those would be illness or having to care for someone who is ill or someone who is unable to fend for themselves, like small children. But these should not be taken lightly. Unfortunately, too many people think that some sports activities are valid reasons to miss Mass. This is ridiculous.

Being on vacation is likewise not an excuse. We don’t take vacations from God. No matter where we are, we can go to <https://masstimes.org> to find a Mass near us. Imagine what an impression it makes on children or fellow travelers when we find a Mass to attend while on vacation!

Especially ridiculous are parents who don’t make sure their children (age 6 and above) attend Mass because they “went earlier during the week at school.” The obligation to attend Mass is for Sunday (or Saturday night). The precept does not say attend Mass “once a week.” I note that none of these kids suddenly show up during the summer months when, of course, they would not have attended a daily Mass at school.

I’m not trying to “put the hammer down” either. But I’ve become aware in the past few years that loyal Catholics were not really taught this precept of the Church about attending Mass every single week. If that’s the case, then “shame on us,” “shame on me.”

One very loyal parishioner told me a few years ago she attended a parish out of State while on vacation. She was surprised to note in their bulletin that attending Mass every Sunday was a strict obligation. And this person is a wonderfully active parishioner! That’s when I began to suspect people were not being adequately catechized.

With all that said, I hope we all come to Mass because we love God, we are committed to being active Catholics, and want to be here. I hope we don’t come to Mass just because “we have to.” And, yes, we won’t always “feel like it.” Let me share a secret with you: I don’t always “feel like” coming to Mass either. I do it because I am committed to doing so. And we all need to do things we don’t “feel like” doing. I imagine folks don’t always “feel like” taking care of their kids or going to work every day.

Of course, all of this—like most things in the Church—is on the Honor System. When people approach Holy Communion—unless they are some notorious character—I have no idea whether or not they are in the “State of Grace.” It is their decision. But I would always give them the benefit of the doubt guessing they may have been to confession prior to approaching Communion. I’m not their judge; they must judge themselves.

The same is true on the recent decision by Marion County Officials to make wearing masks in public optional for those who have somehow been immunized against COVID-19. These are people who have been vaccinated or have already had the virus. It’s up to everyone to be on the Honor System for this as well.

And, thank the Lord, religious houses are now allowed to have 100% capacity. Here at Saint Luke, we will continue to space off the pews on either side of the church for those who feel more comfortable sitting there for the sake of social distancing.
