

Our Archdiocese will be taking up the annual Peter's Pence Collection on June 27, 2021. It is time for St. Luke parishioners to participate, once again, in an annual letter-writing campaign to our two U.S. Senators and their appropriate U.S. Representative, as part of the Bread For The World -Indiana effort. St. Luke has been one of the top parishes over past years. We have been well received by almost all of our bipartisan Indiana Congressional Delegation. As we did last year, we will

be modifying our effort in this era of Coronavirus. This year, the process has been simplified further.

Beyond the food collection efforts that have been such an important part of our Christian Social Action, advocacy will move us toward a world where hunger no longer exists. We have seen the usual lines of people in need of nutrition increase with our economy affected by the pandemic: note the long lines of people/vehicles seeking help. Some of these people never thought they would ever need to join a food line.



PROVIDENCE NEVER FAILS

Dear Parishioners,

I've some sad news to write about this week. Saint Luke Parish is about to encounter two major losses. Both will occur on July 7. December 7 this year will be the 80th anniversary of the attack on the U.S. Naval Base at Pearl Harbor. Five months earlier, July 7th, sure won't be a great day for Saint Luke Parish.

We are losing our parish convent. As you know, for nearly eight years now, through the extraordinary generosity of the owner, our Franciscan Sisters of the Immaculate Heart of Mary have maintained their presence among us living in the house on the Northwest corner of Holliday Drive East and 75th Street.

The owner of this house has decided it is time to sell the property. There seems to be a great uptick in selling houses these days. It's a "sellers market" with houses going for much greater prices than in previous years. She knows it is a great time to sell. I agree. All I can do is thank Marya for her extraordinary generosity in allowing our Sisters to live there.

At this writing, it seems that we have no other option than to have our Sisters move to their large convent at Saint Michael Parish and commute to and from Saint Luke. We won't lose the presence of the Sisters in our preschool and school, but we will lose their prayerful presence living adjacent to our campus. We will miss them dearly.

I suppose we could find another house around here for the Sisters but it would not be the same as having them live, work, and pray "on the property." So, the best option seems to be to move to a neighboring convent maintained by their community.

The Sisters and I have entrusted this problem to Saint Joseph asking for his intercession to help us come up with a plan to keep the Sisters in residence here. Archabbot Lambert Reilly of Saint Meinrad has a great devotion to Saint Joseph. He says that "Saint Joseph is slow but sure!" Well, I hope Saint Joseph picks up the pace. He's got until July 7.

The second loss for Saint Luke on July 7th will be the departure of Msgr. Bill Stumpf. He will remain as Vicar General of the Archdiocese but will also assume

the duties of resident pastor for Saint Matthew Parish. He has lived at Saint Luke Rectory for about the past seven years.

Not only has Msgr. Stumpf been a great help around the parish, but he is a delightful house-mate, friend, and chef! I shall miss his witty presence in the house and around the parish.

We will have a brief thank-you reception for Msgr. Stumpf next weekend, June 26-27, after all the Masses. According to the Mass time, we will have either coffee and doughnuts or cookies and lemonade or iced tea after all the Masses. Weather permitting, we will do this outside at the West entrance to church. If the weather does not cooperate, we will be in the Father Courtney Room.

Stop for a snack and thank Msgr. Stumpf for his presence and his service here at Saint Luke. It's the "second time around" for him here. Saint Luke was his first priestly assignment as associate pastor from 1985-1990. We all shall miss him for sure!

Happy Fathers Day! We will offer a special blessing at Masses this weekend for all the fathers among us. Especially in this Year of Saint Joseph, may God bless and strengthen you in your role!

I wrote above about a crisis in vocations to the priesthood and religious life. But I also think there is another crisis—a crisis in terms of Catholic marriage and family life. Persons who enter religious life or the priesthood come from families—and those families should be where they first learn about Christ, His Church, and are brought to nourishment in the sacraments.

Studies consistently show that the major influence on religious practice in a family is the father. If the father in a family practices his Faith, it is the major determinant of how his children will continue to practice their Faith. What a responsibility! But what a privilege!

Saint Joseph is the patron of all Catholic men, husbands, and fathers. Fathers, ask this great saint to pray with you and for you. Christian marriage and family life is under attack in our culture. Without it, no wonder we have fewer religious vocations!

This week, we archdiocesan priests will have our Clergy Convocation at Saint Meinrad Archabbey Monday-Thursday. Both Msgr. Stumpf and I will be there. We haven't all been together for two years. Pray for us! Thanks to Father Ben and Father Jude we will maintain our regular schedule of Masses and confessions during this time.

A Tip of My Biretta (Hat) to: Long time SMRE (Sunday Morning Religious Education) catechist Michelle Eads. Michelle was recently given The "Catechesis for Discipleship Award." This is a new annual honor given to one catechist from each parish by the archdiocesan Office of Catechesis.

Pastors, parish life coordinators and parish catechetical leaders were asked to identify a catechist who excels at teaching the Faith and witnessing to the life-changing power of a disciple relationship with Jesus lived in full communion with His Body, the holy, Catholic Church. We selected Michelle Eads. Thank you, Michelle! **Stewardship in Action!**

By the way, speaking of SMRE, we need more dedicated catechists to teach in our program. If you are interested or if you would like more information about what is entailed, contact our Parish Director of Religious Education, Sister Diane at dcarollo@stluke.org. Or call the Parish Office.
