

What's Your Hearth Cake?

"Get up and eat, or the journey will be too much for you." I've been to a lot of meetings in my years of work in the Church, and you can take my word for it: the ones with snacks just seem to go better.

I don't know what it is exactly. Maybe it's just that people are in a more agreeable mood if you show up with donuts. Or maybe it's about the very real sense of community and camaraderie that is created at a table where people are engaging in that most human of tasks — eating — beside one another. I think a big part of it comes down to the simple fact that we're all just nicer people when we're fed.

This rings true spiritually, too. We simply must remain fed if we, in turn, are to feed others. PROVIDENCE NEVER FAILS



Dear Parishioners,

This week I've asked our new resident priest here at Saint Luke, Father George, to write this letter to introduce himself to you. Welcome Father George!

Greetings! Blessings of our Lord and Savior be with You!

Making use of this opportunity, I wanted to share a bit of myself with you since I am going to be living at St Luke's as a resident priest.

First of all, thank you for your warm welcome by the staff and the parishioners. So far, whomever I have met has been very cordial and appreciative of my coming here. Even some neighboring families inquire, "what kind of wine do you like "white or red?" If you're curious, I said, "red."

I am the youngest of nine, and my birthday is on November 18. In my family, we have six sisters and three brothers. Sadly, one of my sisters drowned in a river at the age of two, and last year we lost my eldest brother and sister.

At present, my family consists of two brothers and four sisters. Two of my sisters are nuns, Sr. Reema belongs to the medical Mission sisters of St. Joseph, and Sr. Grace Mary, a Carmelite nun.

I was born in a village called Kainakary, in the backwaters of Kerala. If you google it – you will see it, a place of tourist attraction. My father was a farmer, and we had few acres of rice farm. As a child, I loved to fish and swim in the river.

My family's ancestors were converted by St Thomas the Apostle, who came to India in AD 52. They were nomads like Abraham, searching for land to cultivate rice. We bought a house to stay. It belonged to a youngest sister of a Hindu Brahmin family, the word for a more youthful sister is "Nangachi." So we bought her house, and we got the surname Nangachi-veet-

til, (veettill means -in the house of) the younger sister's home.

You can call me Fr. George or Nangachiveettill is hard for you to pronounce.

My vocation to Priesthood: I was an active member of Mission League, an organization for school kids to help the missions; I was also an altar servant. I desired to become a Missionary. After High school, I joined the diocesan seminary. After my studies in philosophy, I joined a religious congregation called Missionaries of Sacred Hearts in Italy. So I got the opportunity to study theology in Rome. I lived in Rome for five years.

Rome is the cradle of Christianity. One of the significant events that I have witnessed in Rome was the shooting of Pope John Paul II at St Peter's Square on May 13, 1982, by Muhammed Ali Aca. I was there at Piazza with my cousin. It is an unforgettable memory because it happened very close to me where I was standing. My cousin was so close, and he could have shaken hands with Pope moments before the shooting occurred.

At the end of my studies in Rome, I joined a mission diocese, Muzaffarpur, North India. Missions in Nepal, Patna- Muzaffarpur, were founded by the Chicago Jesuits. After fifteen years as a missionary, I got an invitation from a priest friend from the Archdiocese of Chicago. That is how I came to States. In Chicago, I worked as a chaplain at the Resurrection Hospital for five years. Then I came to Methodist, Indiana University, and Riley hospitals. I first met Monsignor at St. Peter and Paul Cathedral while he was the Vicar General. I stayed with him for almost two years. I was incardinated to the Archdiocese in 2007. Monsignor was a great support to me in this process of incardination. My first appointment was at St. John the Evangelist (now St. Catherine of Sienna), Enochsburg, DeCATUR county, also St. Maurice at Maurice in 2006. After that, I was appointed as pastor at St. Thomas the Apostle,

Fortville, in 2006. I retired in 2019. I had gone home in 2019. Because of the Pandemic, I could not return to the United States until May 2021. I am happy to be back serving at St. Luke.

Why am I here? When I was staying in Rome, we had an elderly priest who used to tell us, "There is no lack of bread and Sacrament in a convent." The same message I am reading on the walls of St Luke too. 'His Providence never fails'. St Luke Parish is blessed with good people and generous hearts. God has a plan for you and me; that is why we are here. One of my favorite verses from the Old Testament is from the prophet **Jeremiah (29:11)** "For I know the plans I have for you, declares the LORD, plans to prosper you and not to harm you, to give you a future and a hope." One of my favorite hymns is "Great things happen when God mixes with us... great and wonderful ...". Each one of us is a gift of God; everybody in the family is a gift and God's miracle! So I am proud of becoming a member of St Luke's family.

Please keep me in your prayers, and I will be keeping your intentions in my humble prayers. If I can be of any help, feel free to approach me any time. I am learning something new every day at St Luke.


