

STEWARDSHIP

Sharing Your Faith

Question:

My friend has never heard of Christ and I want to share the Gospel with her but I'm afraid to. How do I share my faith?

Answer:

There are a lot of ways to bring up the topic of religion, without being judgmental or pushy. Begin by asking what her thoughts are about religion, or what her experience was growing up. Finding common ground is often easier than you think, because the questions and problems we have about God, the presence of evil, our purpose in life, and our relationship with God are universal concerns.

Why are you afraid? If you do not want to insult or offend someone, don't be pushy or judgmental. If you are uncertain about how to explain your own faith, do a little reading or practice with a friend. If you measure success only by this person converting, focus your attention more on beginning the conversation, not on bringing it to a perfect close! Faith is a journey of many acts of belief, many discussions about God, and many choices about how we practice what we preach. In some we will have great success; in others we will need forgiveness and perseverance. The most important thing to keep in mind is that the Holy Spirit is always at work and our most humble efforts can bear great fruit. Have faith in God because he has faith in you!

SMRE (Sunday Morning Religious Education)

Religion classes for children attending public and private non-Catholic schools began on Sunday, August 22, from 10:45-11:50 a.m. Have you registered your children? Grade 2 children are prepared for First Reconciliation and Communion. 8th grade students are prepared for Confirmation.

Adult Faith Formation and Bible Study

Adults interested in ongoing faith formation should check out the updated parish website on the courses that will be offered starting in September and beyond. Rite Of Christian Initiation Of Adults

- Has anyone you know expressed an interest in becoming Catholic?
- Grew up in a different faith tradition and wants to explore his or her options in terms of the Catholic faith?
- Was baptized Catholic as a child, but has not celebrated the Sacraments of Confirmation and Eucharist?
- Has a child in grade 3 or above who has not been baptized? Ask about RCIC (Rite of Christian Initiation of Children)

St. Luke offers adults and children opportunities to gather together to learn more about the faith. Sessions focus on the teachings and richness of the Catholic faith and prepare individuals to celebrate the Sacraments of Baptism, Confirmation, and Eucharist during the Easter season. There are separate sessions for children or youth. You are welcome to participate in the process with your questions, your insights and your faith story in a warm accepting setting. INDIANA CHOICE SCHOLARSHIP PROGRAM

Background

The Choice Scholarship (voucher) Program was established in 2011 to provide every Indiana student access to the school that best meets their learning needs. The Choice Scholarship provides qualified students financial aid to help pay tuition at a non-public school of their choice.



How to Qualify

STEP 1: MEET INCOME REQUIREMENT: Families must meet the income requirement of 300% of the federal Free or

STEP 2: MEET A PATHWAY: The student must then meet one of the following student eligibility criteria referred to as

- Two Semesters in a Public School Track The student attended an Indiana K-12 public school (including a charter) for at least two semesters immediately preceding the first semester of receiving a Choice Scholarship
- · "F" Public School Track The student would be required to attend a specific public school based on his/her residency that that has been assigned an "F" grade. (However, he or she is not required to attend that public school before becoming eligible nor return to that school should the grade be raised).
- · Special Education Track The student has a disability that requires special education services and has an individualized education plan (IEP) or service plan (SP).
- · Pre-K Track The student received an Early Education Grant (On My Way Pre-K) and is attending kindergarten at the same school that they attended for preschool
- . Foster Care Track The student is in foster care.
- Sibling Track The sibling of the newly applying student received either a Choice Scholarship or an SGO Scholarship in
 a previous school year, including a school year that does not immediately precede the school year for which the student is applying for a Choice Scholarship.
- Previous Scholarship Granting Organization (SGO) Track The student received an SGO Scholarship in a previous school year, including a school year that does not immediately precede the school year for which the student is applying for a Choice Scholarship
- Previous Choice Scholarship Student Track The student received a Choice Scholarship in the school year immediately
 preceding the school year for which the student is applying for a Choice Scholarship.

Frequently Asked Questions

When is the deadline to apply for a 2021-22 Choice Scholarship?

The Indiana Department of Education (IDOE) is currently accepting applications for the fall semester. Applications for this upcoming semester must be submitted by September 1, 2021.

How do I apply for the Choice Scholarship?

Students must first apply and be accepted into a non-public, voucher-accepting school; then the school will submit the student's Choice Scholarship application to the IDOE.

How much funding will my student receive under a Choice Scholarship?

A Choice Scholarship amount is the lesser of:

- Tuition and fees charged at the eligible school or
 90% of the per-student state funding for the student's school corporation of residence.

Does every school accept the Choice Scholarship?

No. Only non-public schools that have applied to the IDOE to be a Choice Scholarship accepting school participate. Currently, there are over 300 Choice accepting schools in Indiana. A full list can be found on the IDOE's website. (https://www.doe.in.gov/choice/2021-2022-participating-choice-schools)

Does the Choice Scholarship last the entirety of my child's education?

No. A Choice Scholarship is awarded annually to a qualified student. A student must apply each year and must continue to meet the program's income eligibility and pathway requirements.

Where can I find more information?

Contact the non-public school of your choice to find more resources and learn if your child might qualify.




30th Street Food Pantry Returns to Indoor Shopping

First Sunday Sharing is Next Weekend

As we all know, poverty exists throughout the year. Our own Saint Luke Christian Social Action Commission (CSAC) and our Saint Vincent de Paul Society (SVdP) work diligently to help those less fortunate than ourselves. First Sunday Sharing has been one of the primary ways in which we as parishioners have helped those in need.

Parishioners receive a CSAC-SVDP envelope in their mailings from the parish. It provides the financial support for these two ministries.

Non-perishable food and men's clothing is collected on the first weekend of each month. The food is distributed at the SVdP "Boulevard Place" Food Pantry (4202 Boulevard Place) and the clothing is given to homeless men who are served each weekend by Beggars for the Poor. The Boulevard Place Food Pantry, a St. Vincent de Paul ministry which is supported by St. Luke and four other north side parishes, provides food assistance to over 900 families in need each month.

Next weekend, September 4/5, is our monthly First Sunday Sharing collection. Thank you for your generous support!


