Our new fiscal year began on July 1, 2021.

While preparing last year's financial report for publication, we wanted to update you on the status of our Sunday offerings for the current year.

Your Finance Council budgeted a two percent increase in Sunday offerings over last year's levels for the new fiscal year. In July, actual contributions were ahead of budget by over \$19,000. While August collections dipped versus budget, we still have a positive variance of just over \$2,000.

# A Letter from Msgr. Schaedel

## PROVIDENCE NEVER FAILS

Dear Parishioners,

Thanks to some **very generous** families, the acquisition and renovation of our Saint Luke Parish Convent is complete! Everyone is invited to an OPEN HOUSE at the convent after 11:30 a.m. Mass until 2:00 p.m. **today, Sunday, September 26.** The convent is at the Northwest corner of Holliday Drive, East, and 75th Street. It's 150 West 75th Street. Come see it; it's wonderful!

This **Tuesday**, September 28, is the 4th Sunday of the month. This means we will have our regular **Holy Hour for Religious Vocations** immediately after the 5:30 p.m. Mass. This consists of Benediction of the Blessed Sacrament, the rosary, time for silent prayer, and prayers for religious vocations. Please join us!

**A Tip of My Biretta (Hat) to:** loyal parishioner Gordon Brooks! Gordon works at Eli Lilly as the chief procurement officer. He is part of a new procurement roundtable formed by the Indianapolis Chamber of Commerce and the Mi-States Minority Supplier Development Council. It aims to help local companies seeking to bolster supplier-diversity efforts.

In the September 10 issue of the **Indianapolis Business Journal**, Gordon said, "Another way to look at procurement is really, how do you get more for your money? How do you make sure that every dollar you're spending isn't only bringing the services you need, but how is it creating value elsewhere in society?"

This is a perfect example of Catholic Social Teaching! The Church supports efforts by businesses to make a decent profit—but at the same time—does so in a way that benefits the overall community. In other words, it makes the world a better place in which to live, work, and therefore glorify God.

Gordon and his family faithfully attend Mass, rain or shine. He is also a member of our Parish Council. Saint Luke is proud of Gordon Brooks and many other parishioners who not only serve our parish and the Catholic Community, but who also serve the wider civic and business community. **Stewardship in Action!**

**Ask Monsignor a Question:** As you know, there is much controversy swirling around Joe Biden, his stance on abortion and other moral issues, and his standing in the Church. If he came to Mass at Saint

Luke, would you allow him to receive Holy Communion? (Via email)

Well, that sure is a loaded question! I'm not trying to dodge the question or the issues, but I would honestly say that I would have to make that decision **when and if** President Biden presents himself here for Mass and Holy Communion.

To be honest, I am more worried about others who present themselves here for Holy Communion. The bottom line is that in order to receive Holy Communion one must be in good standing with the Catholic Church. This implies that they are free from mortal or serious sin. If that's not the case, then it is rather easily remedied by making a good confession.

I worry about people who do not attend Sunday Mass for no good reason. Objectively speaking, this puts them in the state of mortal sin. And if they periodically just show up, without making a good confession, they make what the Church calls a sacrilegious Communion. Saint Paul even says it can be a condemnation.

Unfortunately, this has all been muddled by the recent relaxation of the Sunday Mass obligation because of the pandemic. But that's over now. Our Indiana bishops reinstated this serious obligation of attending Sunday Mass months ago unless there are some other presenting complications, especially health concerns.

More than worrying about Joe Biden, I do worry about folks I've not seen at Mass in months. Yet, I do see them at many other large events, even those here at the parish. How do they justify not going to Mass?

To be honest, I give them the benefit of the doubt. I assume they go to Mass somewhere else for some other reason. I hope I am right. But I suspect I'm not right in many cases. They simply have fallen into the habit of not attending Mass or actually think that watching it on television is the same. It's not.

The same is true for parents who do not see to it that their children go to Mass on a regular basis. The Church says that once a child has reached the "age of reason" (about age six) they are **required** to go to **Sunday Mass**. If a child attends a Catholic School and attends Mass once or twice a week, that's great. But the necessity of attending **Sunday Mass** remains.

I worry about the boys who are faithful in serving Mass, but I never see them at weekend Mass when they are not scheduled to serve. I worry more about all the youngsters who graduated from Saint Luke Catholic School, were confirmed, but also seem to have graduated from attending Mass. I fear that many parents think that sending their sons and daughters to a Catholic School fulfills all their Catholic-parent duties. It does not.

And, while I'm at it, let me mention my concern about parents who allow their children to participate in various activities (mainly sports) on Sunday **mornings**! Some kids tell me they did not attend Mass on Easter Sunday because they were in some sort of tournament. Are these Catholic parents nuts?

Yes, CYO sports play many games on Sundays. But they are always restricted to a starting time no earlier than 1:00 p.m. This gives plenty of time to attend Mass on Sunday morning or the previous Saturday evening. And I could even speculate that attending Sunday games is often a family leisure activity. (Lately, it sure beats a Colts game!)

Sorry to take so long in answering your question, but this one wound me up big time!

To answer your question: At the moment, President Biden is the least of my worries. I am **very concerned** about good people, parishioners whom I dearly love, who have somehow decided that going to Sunday Mass is no longer necessary. They are at the top of the list of my worries. I am not their judge, but I am responsible for guiding them. I do lose sleep over it.

Of one thing I am convinced; of one thing I am certain: Providence never fails!
