## PROVIDENCE NEVER FAILS

Dear Parishioners,

We were delighted to welcome Archbishop Charles Thompson to Saint Luke last Monday, the Feast of Saint Luke. He offered Mass for our Catholic School children.

It all went very well. He was delighted to be able to speak to our well-behaved (and talented) youngsters. The video of the Mass is still available on our parish website: [www.stluke.org](http://www.stluke.org).

Last weekend we celebrated what is called the External Solemnity of our patron, Saint Luke.

This means that despite his actual feast day falling on a Monday this year, we celebrated it as well on the closest weekend to October 18. Last Sunday's Gospel, Mark 10: 45, was a perfect fit for the weekend when we kick off our annual **Stewardship Season**.

It's all a matter of perspective! It depends on how we see things. Consider what we think of when we hear Our Lord speak in last Sunday's Gospel: *"Whoever wishes to be great among you will be your servant; whoever wishes to be first among you will be the slave of all.* Surely Our Lord didn't mean us! Those words must be for somebody else.

Last Tuesday, the Church celebrated the Feast of the North American Martyrs. Eight Catholics martyred for their Faith in upstate New York and Canada in the mid-seventeenth century. I referred to this on my Tuesday Musings. I've always wanted to visit the Shrine of the North American Martyrs in upstate New York.

One of them, Saint Isaac Jogues, after his ordination as a Jesuit priest in France, was told: *"You will go to the New France to die."* And we went. And he was—tortured then murdered. Before he died, Saint Isaac wrote a graphic account of the cruelty endured by another martyr. Rene Goupil had left the seminary; he was a surgeon. If you think Halloween horror movies are gory, you ought to read the torture Saint Rene endured. Valiant people who stopped at nothing—including shedding their blood—to *"be the slave of all,"* as Jesus said. There's one perspective—saints do it—but not me. That's one way to think of it.

Yet these words of Our Lord apply to everybody.

Christ was not just talking to some brave priests, brothers, nuns, or laypeople. He meant these instructions to be servants to others for every one of us. God has given us many gifts. Our very lives, our talents, the freedoms we enjoy, the material things or possessions that people in central Indiana enjoy.

This time of year, Saint Luke Parish puts it into the context of **Stewardship**. The point of true **Stewardship** is that it *all* belongs to God. God has put it all out on loan. We are caretakers; we are stewards of all created things from life to money to skills to talents to our natural resources. We are not masters; we are servants. We need to decide what we are going to do with it all.

We are not alone. Christ is with us. He already did what He now asks us to do. At the end of last Sunday's Gospel, Our Lord states: *"For the Son of Man did not come to be served but to serve and give His life as a ransom for many."* To this day, people take Our Lord at His word.

This parish could not function without the hundreds of generous people who serve as unpaid volunteers. All of the construction we see outside came as a result of parishioners who sacrificed to be part of our **Providence 2021** Capital Campaign. We could not survive the interruption of the pandemic were it not for people who continued their financial commitments—even when churches were closed.

God continues to fill people with extraordinary grace to die to themselves. Kill selfish tendencies. Yet to some generosity means that if we have some *extra*, let's share. But if it's going to make a dent in our schedule or if our wallet is going to take a hit, well, we come first. Don't forget; it's all God's anyway. In the end, God will reclaim it. Christ was a servant. He gives us His grace so we can follow His lead.

Christ is Lord and Master of it all. But even He, the Son of God, came to serve. We are all called to serve. Christ, Himself did it. His grace is there for us. God has given us so much. It's all really His anyway. You will receive a letter from me about your annual Stewardship commitment to your parish. Please pray and then decide how you will respond.

We want a response from **everyone!** Regardless of what you can or cannot

do, please return the card. People are all over the map when it comes to their circumstances regarding their time, talent, or money. Just filling out the card—even if most of it is blank—is a commitment to good **Stewardship**.

Most important is our commitment to prayer and regular Sunday Mass attendance. Pray for vocations to the priesthood and religious life. Our monthly Holy Hour for Vocations is this Tuesday, October 26, at 6:00 p.m. Please join us for Eucharistic Adoration, the rosary, and special prayers for religious vocations.

**A tip of my Biretta (hat) to:** The Jonathan Sturgill Family! They have resurrected our popular Coffee and Doughnuts after 7:30 a.m. and 9:30 a.m. Masses on the first and third Sundays of the month. It's great to be back together for coffee, Long's Doughnuts, and conversation. The Sturgill's have lots of help, but they are responsible for making it happen! Thank you! **Stewardship in Action!**

You can likely see by now it's because the construction crews are delivering the huge steel trusses for the massive addition to the East side of the building. Yes, it's a major inconvenience. But when it's all said and done, we will be delighted with our new parish meeting and storage space, additional classrooms, and school entrance and lobby. (I just hope I get to live long enough to see it!)

Of one thing, I am convinced; of one thing I am certain: Providence never fails!
