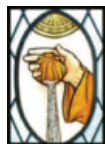

A Letter from Msgr. Schaedel

PROVIDENCE NEVER FAILS



Dear Parishioners,

Two things come to mind immediately as I begin this letter. One is the horrible situation in Ukraine.

The reports and pictures are heart-breaking. Pray for an end to this criminal war; pray for peace and healing for the people of Ukraine. And, as Our Lady asked us at Fatima, pray for the conversion of Communist Russia.

The other thing is the violence here in our own backyard. There was a senseless murder in Carmel and a senseless shooting involving teenagers in our backyard at the J.C.C. It's one more sign that things will never go well unless we as a society include God in our lives and our decision-making.

Lent is underway, and it's already March. This month we have two beautiful feasts we can celebrate amid our Lenten observances: The Solemnity of Saint Joseph on Saturday, March 19, and the Solemnity of the Annunciation on Friday, March 25.

We have additional Masses and devotions during Lent. These were listed in the Lenten insert last week and each week in this bulletin. We will have Mass twice every weekday as usual. The best Lenten practice is to attend an extra Mass or two on weekdays. The Mass is the perfect prayer!

We also have the **Stations of the Cross** offered twice on Fridays. The 2:40 p.m. Way of the Cross is for our school children, but anyone is welcome to attend. We will also have the Way of the Cross right after the 5:30 p.m. Mass on Fridays (about 6:10 p.m.) As always, our **Perpetual Adoration Chapel** is open seven days a week, 24 hours a day for prayer.

We love to judge other people. We get lots of practice when it comes to critiquing others. Some flaw in human nature makes criticizing other people easy. In fact, the sin people most often mention in confession is harshly judging others. It's like we are looking through binoculars. When we look at ourselves, our own faults, we look through the wrong end. Everything appears tiny. But when we look at somebody else, we use the proper lens.

The faults of others are magnified. Often way out of proportion.

When we point our finger at someone

else, we notice that our other three fingers are pointing back to us. America's favorite pastime is judging others. And there is little chance of a players' strike. We tend to judge people.

The perfect time to look at ourselves is right now: during Lent. This is the season for self-inspection. For these forty days, the Church challenges us to take a good hard look at ourselves. We would prefer to judge everyone else. The Church calls us to extra time in prayer, acts of penance, sharing with those in need. Fasting from food is good, yet fasting from judging others could even be better.

We should spend time taking inventory of our own lives. Lent calls us to receive the Sacrament of Penance. We need to spend time deciding what we need to bring to confession during Lent. We judge ourselves. Admit our faults. No one is exempt! Then, once we get an idea of what needs to change in our lives, Lent is the time to work on it.

Most of us are good at being the judge, jury, and executioner for others. Criticizing people is our sport! But God doesn't play the game. God looks for the good in people. We're called upon to do the same. We've got to get better at judging ourselves. Lent is the Church's forty-day self-assessment course.

So, no Lenten program is complete without approaching the **Sacrament of Penance**. We have the North Deanery Penance Services beginning today (Sunday) and on Monday and Tuesday. We have plenty of priests who will be hearing confessions; things will move along. (Unless you have too many sins!) It's also a chance to go to another priest for confession rather than one's parish priest. **Confessions** are heard seven days a week at Saint Luke.

We here at Saint Luke will host the first North Deanery Penance Service today, Sunday, at 2:00 p.m. Saint Simon Parish hosts the Penance Service tomorrow, Monday, March 7, at 7:00 p.m. Saint Pius Parish will host the Penance Service this Tuesday, March 8, at 7:00 p.m.

Almsgiving is giving to the poor or to charity. We will have some second collections each weekend for this purpose during Lent. This weekend, we have a

chance to support the Black and Indian (Native American) Missions in our own country. Next weekend there is a second collection for the work of the Church in Africa.

On **Wednesday, March 9**, we continue our popular **Soup Suppers** after the evening Mass. Beginning this week will again have our popular adult education series for Lent: **Soup and Spirituality**. The evening begins with the 5:30 p.m. Mass, then down to the parish hall for a simple soup supper and speaker. We have a good lineup of speakers.

We begin this week with Ken Ogorek, the Director of Catechesis for the Archdiocese of Indianapolis. Ken's topic is "How to be the Ideal Disciple of Jesus: Humble, Hungry, Smart—and Beyond!" Ken is a great presenter. He will also be with us on March 16. His topic then will be "Renewal, Decision, and Comfort."

Our next parish **Fish Fry** is Friday, March 18. Thanks to our own Knights of Columbus Council, we will be treated to a delicious fish dinner. Carryout is available. Tickets are on sale in the Narthex after the Masses—or just buy one at the door.
