A Letter from Msgr. Schaedel

PROVIDENCE NEVER FAILS



Dear Parishioners,

Holy Week 2022 is here. The wonderfully rich liturgical celebrations of **Palm Sunday, the Chrism Mass** at the cathedral, **Holy Thursday, Good Friday, Holy Saturday, and Easter Sunday** are beautiful.

I wish more people attended the **Triduum Liturgies**. Holy Week Liturgies are so meaningful. I, too often, hear, "O, it is so long!" Well, they are not that long. Christ hung on the cross for you for three long hours on Good Friday. None of these Liturgies are that long or painful. Our schedule for **Holy Week** is printed elsewhere in this bulletin.

The Sacrament of Penance is a must for a good Lent. Confessions are heard seven days a week here at Saint Luke: 5:00 p.m. Monday through Saturday and at 11:00 a.m. Sunday. Confessions will also begin early at 4:30 p.m. on Monday, April 11; Wednesday, April 13; and after 3:00 p.m. Good Friday Service until all are finished. There are no confessions scheduled for Holy Saturday.

The annual **Chrism Mass** is this Tuesday, April 12, at 2:00 p.m. at SS. Peter and Paul Cathedral, 14th and Meridian. During this Mass, Archbishop Thompson will bless the Holy Oils used in the administration of the sacraments: The Oil of the Sick, the Oil of Catechumens for Baptisms, and Sacred Chrism used at Baptism and Confirmation. These blessed oils are kept in the ambry located on the wall near our baptismal font.

During the **Chrism Mass**, we priests renew the promises that we made on the day of our ordination. All are welcome. Because of the Chrism Mass downtown, we will not have evening confessions or Mass here this Tuesday, April 12.

It can be very meaningful to make our 8th Grade School **Passion Play** part of your Holy Week preparation. Our students do a marvelous job in prayerfully portraying the final moments of Our Lord's Life. This Passion Enactment is more than a play; it is a prayer. The main performance is this Wednesday, April 13, at 7:00 p.m. in church. Please come!

Make special note of **Holy Thursday** evening's **Adoration of the Most Blessed Sacrament** after Mass. As Jesus was taken away by the guards, Jesus is "taken away" from the main

tabernacle in church to the "repository." In our case, this is located in our Magnificat (daily Mass) Chapel. We are invited to spend time with Him just as He invited His apostles to do in the Garden before His arrest. (Cf. Mark 14: 32-38) **Solemn Adoration** of the Blessed Sacrament continues until midnight.

By next Sunday, more folks will be full-fledged Catholics! The **Catechumens** will be baptized. **Candidates** (those validly baptized in another Christian denomination) will make First Confession, then be received into the Catholic Church, be confirmed, and receive First Holy Communion along with the catechumens on Saturday night.

I want to thank our parish Director of Religious Education, Sister Diane Carollo, and our RCIA Team, who, since last September has faithfully worked with these candidates to prepare them for this night. **Stewardship in Action!**

Our second collection this week is for the **Holy Places** in the Holy Land. These sacred places must be preserved. We need to come to the aid of Christians who live in the Holy Land. Life for Christians there is rough.

This second collection helps the Church maintain the holy sites there. It also assists young Catholics who want to remain in their home land—the Holy Land. But so often, they feel they must move in order to get an education or a job because of the obstacles there. (Imagine! In the Holy Land—the home land of Our Lord Himself!)

A tip of my Biretta (hat) to: Rita Whalley, our faithful weekday evening Mass sacristan. Like most of the sacristans, hers is a rather hidden ministry but all-important. Sacristans prepare all of the liturgical vessels, books, and other items needed for Mass. During the weekdays, they usually need to make sure we have a lector unless it is a school Mass.

Rita is here Monday through Friday for the evening Masses. You can imagine what a great help she is! She is often here for a Sunday Mass too.

Several years ago, when evening Mass was most often celebrated in the chapel, Rita remarked to me how wonderful it might be if the numbers coming to Mass made it necessary for us to move Mass into the large church. Well, that day has arrived—at least for now. The Magni-

ficat (daily Mass) Chapel comfortably seats about 70. But numbers coming most evenings require us to offer the Mass in the main church!

Ask Monsignor a Question: *What was the controversy among some Catholics about the pope's consecration of Russia and Ukraine to Mary? I read that some people think it was not done "right."* (Via E-mail)

In my opinion, that is all a bunch of nothing. So, I'm not going to spend much time or space on it here.

The gist of it is that Our Lady asked the pope over a hundred years ago to consecrate Russia and its Communist errors to her Immaculate Heart. More than one pope, including Pope Saint John Paul II, has done so. But in those cases, the Holy Father prayed something like "for all the world" and did not specifically mention Russia. I guess I always thought Russia was part of the "whole world."

Others claim Pope Francis should not have included Ukraine with Russia. Yet when Our Lady asked for this to be done Ukraine was still a part of the Soviet Union. Popes are like pastors: there is no shortage of people who claim to know more than they do and are willing to share their infinite wisdom.

I fear most of this is the superstitious notion that in order to manipulate God into answering our prayers, we need the right magic words. I do think we need to do what God asks. But I don't think God responds or helps only when we happen to get the right "magic formula."

Of one thing, I am convinced; of one thing I am certain: Providence never fails!
