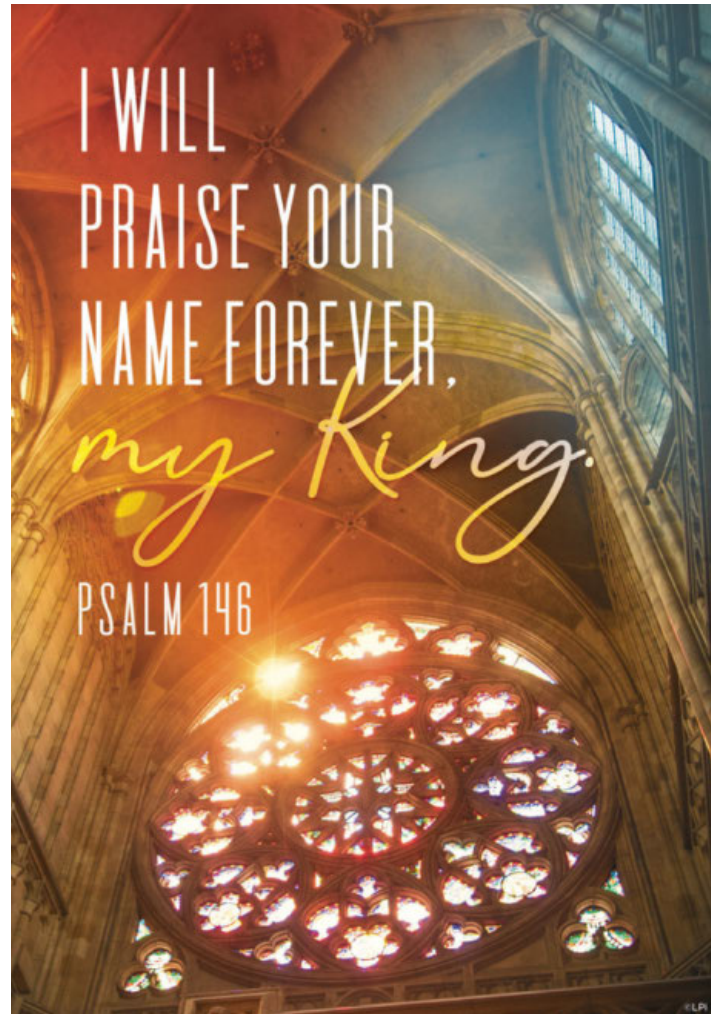

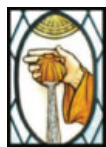

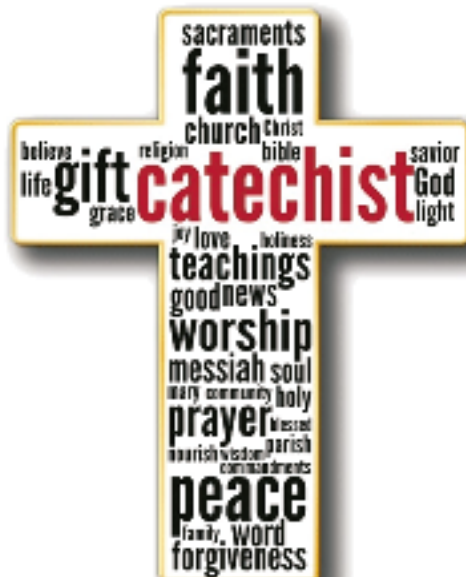

A Letter from Msgr. Schaedel

PROVIDENCE NEVER FAILS



Dear Parishioners,

Today, Sunday, May 15, and next Sunday, May 22, are memorable days for me. It was 67 years ago today, May 15, that I made my First Holy Communion at Holy Name of Jesus Church in Beech Grove. The parish had just completed a new church building and our class was the first to make First Communion in that church.

I have many good memories. I still have my little First Communion prayer book and rosary at my bedside. Details of the event are inscribed there in my dear mother's handwriting.

Next Sunday, May 22, I will celebrate my 40th Anniversary of Priestly Ordination! It was on this date in 1982 that I was ordained to the Sacred Priesthood by Archbishop Edward O'Meara at our cathedral downtown. It was the happiest day of my life!

I look forward to celebrating this anniversary with my own family and you, my parish family, next Sunday. The Mass begins at 3:30 p.m. followed by a huge celebration in an open-air tent in the North parking lot. I hope you will be there! The committee told me it's about "sold-out." Of course, there is no charge but we can only accommodate so many people in terms of tables, chairs, food, and Scotch.

Does anyone have roots in or a special affection for our now closed Holy Cross Parish on the near East side? It was a long-time beacon on what we called "Irish Hill." Because of extensive deterioration of the building the archdiocese closed it a few years ago.

Anyhow, I want to rescue some liturgical items from the church: a large crucifix and statue of the Sacred Heart and a stained-glass window. But I need some money to make it all work—about \$10,000.00. Let me know if you want to help!

A Tip of My Biretta (Hat) to: our own Jamison Downs. He was featured recently in a special edition of the *Indianapolis Business Journal* naming "40 out of 40" outstanding business persons and community leaders. Jamison is a managing partner of Veritas Realty. He is a graduate of the University of Dayton. He and his wife, Hillary, are school parents here. Jamison has also been active in fundraising at Saint Luke. **Stewardship in Action!**

Ask Monsignor a Question: *What do you mean by "active parishioner?" Why are people asking about this?*

This goes back to last week's question from a new school family moving into the parish this summer. If you did not read my response last week, you might want to do so now so as to better understand what I'm going to write this week. Many people have inquired asking basically the same question above.

Much of the response to this has to do with school tuition rates. Although, I would think that any Catholic in any parish would want to be classified as an "active parishioner."

Over the years, the Archdiocese of Indianapolis has been blessed with archbishops and other leaders who have had a strong commitment to Catholic Schools. These archbishops and leaders have done all they could to make sure that a Catholic School education is available and affordable for all who want it. Thank God!

One of the ways they have done this is to insist that all parishes who have a Catholic School or one within a reasonable distance, support it financially and otherwise. In addition to tuition, the parishes contribute a subsidy to support each school.

I remember years ago when I was the vicar general of the archdiocese one pastor (now retired) decided his parish would not financially support its elementary school. He would charge full tuition. Archbishop Buechlein put a quick stop to that line of thinking. His opinion, and mine as well, is that the entire Church (parish) has a responsibility to give our children the best Catholic Education possible.

Over 60 years ago, when I was in Catholic elementary school, our parents paid no tuition! The parish completely funded our Catholic education and the dedicated Sisters worked for peanuts to make it all possible. So, I really don't know who all paid my elementary school education at Holy Name of Jesus, but I pray for them to this day.

But times have changed. Parents now pay tuition—but not full tuition. The parish still helps by subsidizing the Catholic School.

Here is how it goes now at Saint Luke: The cost to educate a single child at

Saint Luke Catholic School next year will be \$8,445.00. If someone is not an active parishioner, that is their tuition rate. If a parent is an active parishioner, their tuition rate is \$5,550.00. That's a difference of \$2,895.00. How do we make that difference up? Saint Luke Parish pays it from our holyday and Sunday collections.

It seems then, that any parishioner who gets this generous discount should be an "active parishioner" financially. In terms of "evening things up," that means an "active parishioner" should be contributing at least \$50.00 per week in the weekend collection to cover the gap. They also can claim this contribution on their taxes.

The same scenario is true of Saint Luke children who attend our North Deanery High School, Bishop Chatard. Next year, the cost to educate one student at BCHS will be \$13,415.00. The tuition for active parishioners from Saint Luke or any other North Deanery Parish will be \$10,290.00. That's a gap of \$3,125.00. Who makes it up? Saint Luke Parish does for our students.

Of course, in the case of families with multiple students, the numbers increase accordingly. However, in both schools, there is considerable financial aid available including the incredibly generous Indiana Choice Scholarships (vouchers). I urge all families to investigate this. The number of families who are potentially eligible for these scholarships is incredible.

I hope this helps explain the "ins and out's" of the "active parishioner" status. It makes a big difference. I hope that every parent is honest with God and themselves when it comes to their weekly contribution to the parish. I've never made a hard and fast rule as to what they must contribute. And I don't intend to start. But I want everyone to understand how all this works.

Of one thing I am convinced; of one thing I am certain: Providence never fails!

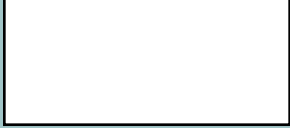

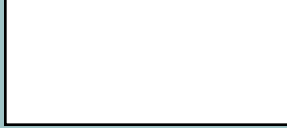
