Anointing of the Sick


Please call the office if a loved one is seriously ill or in the hospital.

Thus you and I gather together in this church among our families and friends to reflect upon what God has done for us. We come together to worship in wonder and amazement at the resurrection of God's son who is Christ our Lord. This is also a time of a joyful new beginning in Jesus Christ for us as we renew our baptismal promise.
