

A MESSAGE FROM FR. MILLER/OTHER

Friends,

Peace be with you.

There's an episode of Star Trek the Next Generation entitled "Justice" in which one of the characters named Wesley Crusher violates a law of a planet he and other members of the crew were visiting. As it is their first visit to the planet, none of them knew that the only punishment for violating laws on the planet was capital punishment, the death penalty. So, in Wesley's case, when he broke a panel on a greenhouse, he is immediately confronted by a security officer threatening him with lethal injection.

This story sticks in my imagination because, even though I suspect we'd all say that it's nonsensically harsh to kill someone for breaking a greenhouse panel, I wonder if we sometimes think similar thoughts. Some people, for instance, call for capital punishment for people convicted of pedophilia. Some people call for capital punishment for drug dealers or terrorists. Some people think a person who smokes or doesn't get vaccinated or doesn't exercise deserves to die of cancer or coronavirus or diabetes. I'll shamefacedly admit there have been times when I've heard a story about someone who seems unrepentant for a bad action like stealing money from the elderly where I think to myself that the thief isn't going to contribute positively to society and I wonder if the world would be better off without them. I know that sounds harsh and I immediately regret thinking that way but I have a feeling I'm not alone in this sentiment. Still, I wouldn't want either that person, or certainly my God, treating me in the same way if I were in his shoes. I would want them to recognize my dignity even if I'm not acting in a way deserving of that recognition.

This month we are called to recognize the dignity of the human person, largely because it is the anniversary of the very unjust court decision Roe v. Wade, which made abortion legal. I am one, however, who agrees with the late Cardinal Joseph Bernadine that, while abortion is a particular evil both because of the number of abortions performed and the innocence of the person on whom it is performed, nonetheless we must stand against all threats to human life from natural conception to natural death. Saint John Paul II, in his Theology of the Body, based much of his teaching on the dignity of the human person on Genesis chapter one, where humanity is the pinnacle of creation because we are uniquely created in God's image. However, I wonder if we might also turn to the phrase from the Our Father, "forgive us our trespasses as we forgive those who trespass against us" to strengthen his argument. It seems that we are called to forgive others in order to be forgiven because there is a connection between human beings that transcends the wrong done. In other words, it doesn't matter what the other person does, they are still created in God's image and when we forgive them, we are really doing so because of that image.

Forgiveness is a challenge, especially when we are certain that the person will probably hurt us again the next time we interact. I personally can only do it by reminding myself to look for the image of Christ in someone I don't

particularly like and not simply seeing in them an adversary to be overcome. It's what we, as Christians, are called to do: to forgive. It's comforting that we aren't called to be perfect and, yet, a challenge to forgive. Still, I'd rather it be this way than have a god or society that punishes first and asks for repentance and forgiveness never. And I'd rather see the image of God in the guilty because there are times when I am guilty.

Lord, help us to see your image in others when we forgive them and when we ask for their forgiveness.
