

#### From Fr. Von's Desk

May you all have a Blessed Christmas as we celebrate the birth of the Son of God made man, Jesus Christ.

We see the meaning of Christmas described in the prayers from our Christmas Masses. At the Vigil Mass, we pray that, as we joyfully welcome God's Son as our Redeemer, we may also be able to face him confidently as our Judge. So, may we welcome Jesus now and ask for the forgiveness and help we need to be welcomed into his heavenly kingdom. We pray that we might always welcome him every day of our lives.

In the Mass during the Night, we pray that Jesus, the true Light, may make his light known to us on earth and that we might also delight in his gladness in heaven. At the Prayer Over the Offerings and the Prayer after Communion, we pray that, through this holy exchange, as God the Son becomes man, we might become more the likeness of Christ; that, through an honorable way of life, we may become worthy of union with him.

At the Mass at Dawn, we pray that God may be seen in our works as his light of faith illumines our minds. At the Prayer after Communion, we pray that we may know the hidden depths of this mystery of the Incarnation, God becoming man, with fullness of faith.

In the Mass During the Day, we pray the prayer that the deacon or priest prays when he mixes water with the wine in the chalice at the Offertory: "May we share in the divinity of Christ who humbled himself to share in our humanity." Yes, God became one of us so that we could be united with him forever. We are given a share in God's divine life in Baptism and it is strengthened throughout our lives by Jesus acting in the sacraments. May that life continue to grow in us throughout our earthly lives.






