## Father Bob's Corner

### The Song Remains the Same!

The tale is told of a young man who discovered a beautiful song that touched his heart and inspired him to sing, first silently and then aloud. Others heard his voice and its words, which almost danced through the air and into their hearts. Before long, they too were singing. Person by person, the music spread throughout the land, promising ever more freedom and joy as the number of singers increased.

Some people disliked the song and objected to its message of hope, which seemed to threaten their very existence. They believed that something had to be done to silence this song. The leaders dispatched a detachment of soldiers to arrest and imprison the young man who had begun the cascade of song. Yet he continued singing, his voice soaring to the skies beyond the bars of his cell. Other prisoners heard him and joined in the chorus.

Enough was enough! The only way to silence the song would be to kill the singer. An armed guard marched him to the courtyard in the center of the prison and fastened him, still singing, to a pole in the ground. The senior officer gave the order, the guns barked and, at last, there was silence, but only for a second. From every cell in the prison, one inmate after another started singing the same song that had cost the young man his life. This time, in spite of the death of the young singer, his song spread throughout the world. It could not be stopped. The song was greater than the authorities who had tried to destroy it.

Blessed Miguel Pro's feast day was celebrated by the Catholic Church just a couple of weeks ago. He was a young Jesuit who was executed without trial for the wrongful accusation of trying to assassinate the president. His crime? He had faithfully served the oppressed and suppressed Mexican Church during the Calles dictatorship. His song? He shouted, "Viva Cristo Rey!" ("Long live Christ the King!") Like John the Baptist, Pro was a singer who willingly gave his life for the song that had touched his heart and inspired his music.

The song of true freedom remains the same today. If I were charged with being a Christian, would there be enough evidence to convict me? Do we have the courage to sing it with all our hearts, like Miguel Pro and John the Baptist, so everyone will know that our true allegiance belongs to Jesus Christ?



**Eating nuts strengthens your brain waves**

I remember growing up, Christmas was always the time we would be gifted with great big walnuts, pecans, almonds, brazil nuts, etc. I remember how special this gift was. Well now we have research that shows that nuts are good brain food. A new study at Loma Linda University Adventist Health Sciences Center has actually measured their powerful effect in the form of brain waves.

According to Dr. Adria Scmedthorst, this study was performed using people who ate six types of nuts: almonds, cashews, peanuts, pecans, pistachios and walnuts. In this research they found that all of the nuts tested were beneficial for strengthening brain waves. In other words, eating nuts on a regular basis can actually strengthen your brainwave frequencies to improve your cognition, healing, learning, memory and other key brain functions. According to the researchers, that's because nuts have high concentrations of flavonoids-antioxidants believed to have anti-inflammatory, anti-cancerous and heart-protective effects. Previous research has shown that these flavonoids can enter areas of your brain's hippocampus that are responsible for learning and memory. Thanks to this research, you now know how important it is to incorporate nuts into your daily diet to boost your brain power. Do remember that nuts also pack a punch when it comes to calories, so adjust your diet accordingly.

Here are some ways, you can enjoy more nuts:

- \* Spread nut butter on your morning toast instead of butter or cream cheese.
- \* Sprinkle chopped nuts on cereal or yogurt.
- \* Toss nuts into a green or fruit salad.
- \* Add halved cashews to your Asian stir-fry.
- \* Top fruit or crackers with nut butter.
- \* Try nut-encrusted fish or chicken, such as pecan-encrusted trout.
- \* Make your own nut and seed mix by lightly toasting almonds, walnuts, sunflower and pumpkin seeds in a 160-170 degree oven for 15-20 minutes. Add extra flavor by mixing your favorite spices, like cumin, cinnamon, turmeric and cayenne pepper.
- \* Toss chopped almonds or pecans and steamed green beans in a bowl with olive oil, minced garlic, salt and pepper for a tasty side dish.
- \* Soak walnuts for six to eight hours then chop in food processor with parsley, onion, garlic, lemon juice and olive oil for a perfect pate.

Check with you doctor before eating nuts if you have any conditions that would prohibit you from enjoying nuts.

### Pro-Life Corner

**Was it necessary for God to make Mary immaculate at her conception so that she could be Jesus' mother?**

**No.** The Church only speaks of the Immaculate Conception as something that was "fitting". Something that made Mary a "fit habitation" (i.e. suitable dwelling) for the Son of God, not something that was necessary. Thus in preparing to define the dogma, **Pope Pius IX stated:**

*And hence they (the Church Fathers) affirmed that the Blessed Virgin was, through grace, entirely free from every stain of sin, and from all corruption of body, soul, and mind; that she was always united with God and joined to him by eternal covenant; that she was never in darkness, but always in light; and that, therefore, she was entirely a fit habitation for Christ, not because of the state of her body, but because of her original grace.*

*For it was certainly not fitting that this vessel of election should be wounded by the common injuries, since she, differing so much from the others, had only nature in common with them, not sin. In fact, it was quite fitting that, as the Only Begotten has a Father in heaven, whom the Seraphim extol as Thrice Holy, so He should have a Mother on earth who would never be without the splendor of holiness.*
