



## Father Bob's Corner

### Celebrating Our Central Sacrament

#### The Most Holy Body and Blood of Christ

Holy Family Catholic Church in Oldenburg, Indiana, holds an annual Corpus Christi procession on this solemnity. This will be the 175<sup>th</sup> consecutive year that this procession takes place in that charming village. It remains a popular event; people from the Tristate area (Indiana, Ohio, & Kentucky) attend and sometimes visitors from Europe. The crowd increases every year and most of the parishioners have roles to play.



The procession starts immediately after the 10 a.m. Mass. Beginning at the front door of the church, the procession visits seven shrines. At each shrine, people sing hymns, followed by Benediction. They walk through beautiful woods, the convent grounds of the Franciscan sisters across the street, and the village streets. The procession seems to get more popular with each passing year.

As the people welcome the summer season, they celebrate the real presence of Jesus in their lives and remind themselves of the divine relationship that never ends. Even though modern culture may not appreciate religious processions, it remains a truly "hearth and home" event in this village. Summer takes on an even brighter hue!

Traditions can be a very good thing. Our church has many colorful and loving traditions. Processions on this day are only one example. Maybe you have family traditions that you treasure and pass on from generation to generation. June 22 marks the first day of summer. As we welcome the summer season, we are reminded through today's Feast of the Most Holy Body and Blood of Christ to deepen our relationship with the real presence of Jesus in the Eucharist we share.

Our faith traditions offer us all we need to be spiritually at peace. What others may deem as antiquated or a relic of the past remains true and makes living our lives richer and deeper. God's blessings are eternal. They don't need upgrades or the current year's model. It is so very important to remember our blessings and not forget all that God has done for us. ### Get Moving!

Walking Has Many Benefits! Do you want to lose weight and improve your heart health? Now with this beautiful weather, we have ample opportunities to be walking outdoors – but indoor walking workouts are also beneficial. Looking for more reasons to walk? Read on for more inspiration. Walking may help to add years to your life. More steps that you walk, lowers your mortality rate and cuts the risk of stroke in half. Walking grows your brain.

Studies show that regular aerobic exercise appears to increase the size of the hippocampus which is the area of the brain responsible for memory. Regular cardio exercise helps to reduce the abdominal fat that puts a person at risk for diabetes, high blood pressure and heart disease. Research is showing that there is a link between a decreased risk of age-related cataracts and glaucoma.

Walking and being socially active help to decrease chronic sleep problems by helping a person fall asleep and stay asleep. Try mindful walking for stress-busting benefits. This means that while walking you clear your mind and listen to the birds, look around at nature and take deep breaths. Being active helps to ward off depression and will provide long term health benefits helping to maintain mobility and independence. It is never too late to experience the benefits of being more active. Plan your day to include a time for walking indoors or outdoors to benefit your health in many ways. Here are some benefits when you add walking to your day:

- Boost your immune system. It is possible to boost your immune system on a daily basis by being intentional about areas of your life. Be active for thirty to sixty minutes most days of the week.
- Eat a diet rich in fruits, vegetables, whole grains and healthy fats. Check on the Mediterranean diet for more ideas.
- Stay on top of stress. Adopt healthy strategies to help you manage your reaction to stress.
- Get enough sleep as sleep reboots the immune system.
- Find out if your vitamin D level is where it should be by talking with your health care practitioner.
- Additional tips: Do not smoke. Drink alcohol in moderation, if at all. Take steps to avoid infection. Staying healthy involves planning, organizing and taking action!


