



## Father Bob's Corner

### Thankful for the Opportunity to Be Your Servant!

It was an early Monday morning in October, of 2008, when I received a phone call from the then Vicar for Clergy, Monsignor Eric Barr. He said he would like to see me and that he had something important to talk to me about. He also assured me that it was something very good. I mentioned that I was about to go on my annual Fall Priests Retreat, starting that evening. He said that he would meet me at the Retreat House before the Retreat began. All day I wondered what he might want to talk to me about. I wondered if he might actually ask me to become the founding pastor of the new parish in Sugar Grove, which became a reality due to the very generous gift of land and money from Jerry Rich and his late father Anthony Rich.



Well, that is exactly what Monsignor Eric Barr wanted to talk to me about. I was immediately excited, but also felt some sadness that I would be leaving St. Mary Parish, in Woodstock, IL, after only 17 months, which has been my shortest stint at any of the assignments I have had in my now 29 years of priesthood. I felt like we were just beginning to get some good things established there when this new opportunity was presented to me; yet I felt that not only the Bishop, but that the Lord Himself, was calling me to Sugar Grove.

Now, some 12 years and 7 months later, I have a strong sense that not only the Bishop, but also the Lord Himself, is calling me to a new challenge, at a new assignment. Despite this belief and conviction, this is by no means an easy time for me. For the past 12 years and 7 months I have truly poured my heart and soul into being the founding pastor of St. Katharine Drexel Parish, in Sugar Grove, IL. I have witnessed so many wonderful relationships that have formed and grown over the years. It has been a true blessing to see the gifts of time, talent and treasure from so many come together to form this wonderful faith community! Thank you for your Discipleship and for being Church! I will miss you more than you will ever know! You have been a family to me!

Not too long after I first joined the Rockford Diocese, back in the spring of 1987, I met Fr. Stephen St. Jules for the first time. I was impressed with his priestly personae then, and over the years my respect and admiration for him has only grown. In Fr. St. Jules, St. Katharine Drexel has a very good man, indeed, to become the 2<sup>nd</sup> pastor of this fine parish. I pray you embrace him with open arms and hearts! He will need your spirit of welcome and support, and I trust that you will soon find in him a very capable and loving Shepherd.

It has been said "The Saddest Goodbye is the Goodbye, in which there is no Sadness." I find that statement to be so very true. I know that I am not the only one who is feeling sadness right now, and that is because we have shared something very meaningful over the past 12 and a half years. Now it is time for a new chapter to begin, both at St. Katharine Drexel and in my own life, as well. In the midst of our sadness, we also have reason to be a people with great hope. Please pray for me as I begin my new parish, for I certainly will need your prayers, and also be assured of my continued prayers for all the good people of St. Katharine Drexel.
