



## From our Seminarian Grant

### A reflection on Saint Augustine of Hippo:

In his book on priestly discernment, *To Save A Thousand Souls*, Fr. Brett Brannen describes a type of man who feels as though he is called to enter seminary, but does not do so either out of fear or because it is more comfortable to “sit on the fence” of indecision. Fr. Brannen explains that in this situation it is harder for God to move a “fence sitter” than it is to convert someone who is moving in the wrong direction. A practical example of Fr. Brannen’s theory can be found in the life of St. Augustine, one of the Church’s greatest saints.



Perhaps St. Augustine’s most admirable trait is his passion. Pick up a copy of *The Confessions* and you will see quickly that his life and his rhetoric are filled with passion and zeal for life. For most of his adolescent years, Augustine channeled this passion in the wrong direction. He takes note of these years by saying “There was a time in adolescence when I was afire to take my fill of hell”. It is easy to see, as one looks at the rest of Augustine’s life, that once he turned his heart towards God, it was full steam ahead. In the last chapter of *The Confessions*, Augustine clarifies this by saying “once our heart had conceived by your Spirit we made a fresh start and began to act well, though at an earlier stage we had been impelled to wrongdoing and abandoned you”.

A good lesson can be learned by looking at the passion and zeal by which Augustine lived his life. Though for most of his youth Augustine was moving in the wrong direction, he was at least moving. Once converted, Augustine’s energy was directed towards the glory of God and the coming of his Kingdom. Now, I am not saying that in order to draw closer to Jesus Christ we must first move in the wrong direction. We must always be diligent in doing good and avoiding evil. However...always be moving! God always gives us the grace to move in the right direction, and as St. Thomas Aquinas teaches us, grace builds upon nature. If we are tempted to sit still, God’s grace will have a harder time breaking into our lives than if we are slowly moving in the right direction. So don’t be a “fence sitter”. God in his love gives us the tools to follow him: prayer and the sacraments always help us along the path of holiness. So do not be discouraged if you are far off the path. Get up, and take that first step in the right direction. If the life of Augustine teaches us anything, it’s that great sinners can indeed become great saints.




### “Bach and Beyond” Organ Concert at the Abbey



**Exercise Can Save Your Life and Save You Money**

Exercise is the **NUMBER ONE** way to improve our health as we grow older. On average, seniors who exercise live longer, decrease their risk of a host of ailments, and better manage their existing health conditions. They improve their mood, lower their pain level, and enjoy better function. It is said now, and most experts agree, that exercise is the best "prescription" for brain health. More and more research studies provide us with plenty of motivation to get off the couch and lace up our gym shoes

There was a recent study published in the Journal of the American Heart Association which showed that exercise can lower healthcare costs-both for the nation and for individual patients as well. It seems there is no better pill for reducing the risk of disease and healthcare costs than optimizing physical activity.

People of every age can benefit from regular physical activity. It's never too late to start! No matter what your age or health status, an appropriate exercise program can improve your health and quality of life. As always, make sure you talk to your healthcare provider before beginning an exercise program depending on any health conditions you may have. Some very helpful exercises to start with include:

- \* **Aerobic exercise**, which includes walking, swimming, dancing—anything that makes the heart pump faster and makes us breathe a little harder.
- \* **Muscle-strengthening exercises**, such as lifting weights, using a resistance band, using special equipment at a gym, or doing activities that make you lift your own body weight, such as Pilates, or my favorite, Pietra Fitness.
- \* **Flexibility exercises**, such as stretches to improve range of motion and freedom of movement.
- \* **Balance exercises**, to improve our sense of position and reduce the risk of falls.

Now there is so much information of connecting exercise with brain health! Recent research shows that it is best to do a variety of exercises each week. Don't be afraid to try something new and get moving! If all else fails, play with your grandchildren and they will definitely give you a great workout.





The Sugar Grove Associates of the Sisters of the Blessed Sacrament wish to thank you for your generosity in providing needed supplies to Catholic American Indian Mission schools. Your response has been overwhelming with gifts of notebooks, binders, paper, pens, pencils, crayons, markers, office supplies, art supplies, and children's books, far exceeding our expectations!!

This year the ASBS has selected St. Mary's Mission and School serving the Native American Ojibwa on the Red Lake Reservation in far Northern Minnesota as the recipient of donations. It is in the poorest area of the state, in which 1 in 3 people live below the poverty level. It is one of the oldest Indian missions, and as a young woman, St. Katharine Drexel first visited Red Lake in 1888 and assisted in forming this school and mission.

The St. Mary's Mission and School continue effectively to this day, educating Ojibwa children to grow in faith; develop cultural pride; and achieve academic excellence. This small school is effectively improving the quality of life of America's native peoples, while producing Ojibwa future leaders within the Tribe, and within the Catholic Church.

We wish to extend our blessings and a sincere "Miigwetch" (Thank You) for sharing in St. Katharine's mission to serve the Native American children. We know that the schools will find these items useful and pray these many gifts will have a positive effect on the lives of the school staff and the children as they progress in their Catholic education. May God bless all in the St. Katharine Drexel community for your generosity and spirit.




