

The Chaplet of Saint Michael



In 2001 I had the opportunity to travel to Hanceville, Alabama and visit the *Shrine of the Most Blessed Sacrament of Our Lady of the Angels Monastery*. Mother Angelica was the prioress at the time. After concelebrating Mass in the church we were invited into the "meeting room" where Mother Angelica, along with several of her nuns, greeted. While there, Mother Angelica gave me a beautiful rosary and booklet for praying the Chaplet of St. Michael.

The Chaplet is a powerful prayer that can arm us against the devil and his evil ways. Its history can be traced back to Antonia d'Astonac, a Portuguese Carmelite nun who received a vision of Saint Michael. In the vision, he asked to be honored by a prayer that salutes the nine choirs of angels. The vision was approved by Pope Pius IX in 1851. St. Michael promised Sr. Antonia that those who prayed the chaplet would have his continual protection and assistance in daily life and at death.

Our Catholic faith teaches that angels have been present since creation and throughout salvation history. When Christ comes back at the final judgement, the angels will accompany Him.

In 1917, Padre Pio made a pilgrimage to the oldest Shrine in Western Europe, dedicated to Saint Michael the Archangel. Padre Pio would often send penitents to the Shrine to pray for the intercession and protection of Saint Michael for the salvation of their souls. He encouraged his spiritual children to have devotion to the Holy Archangel, because "you will need the help of Saint Michael living in this world!"

The *Chaplet of Saint Michael* begins with the invocation on the medal. This is followed by nine salutations in honor of the nine Choirs of Angels. After each salutation you say an Our Father and three Hail Marys. The chaplet ends with four Our Fathers, one each for Archangels: Michael, Gabriel, Raphael, and your Guardian Angel. A prayer to Saint Michael concludes the chaplet.

Invocation on the Medal

O God, come to my assistance! O Lord, make haste to help me! Glory be to the Father, and to the Son, and to the Holy Spirit, as it was in the beginning is now and ever shall be. Amen.

First Salutation

Through the intercession of St. Michael and the celestial Choir of Seraphim, may it please God to make us worthy to receive into our hearts the fire of His perfect charity. Amen. (1 Our Father and 3 Hail Marys)

Second Salutation

Through the intercession of St. Michael and the celestial Choir of Cherubim, may God grant us the grace to abandon the ways of sin, and follow the path of Christian perfection. Amen. (1 Our Father and 3 Hail Marys)

Third Salutation

Through the intercession of St. Michael and the celestial Choir of Thrones, may it please God to infuse into our hearts a true and earnest spirit of humility. Amen. (1 Our Father and 3 Hail Marys)

Fourth Salutation

Through the intercession of St. Michael and the celestial Choir of the Dominations, may it please God to grant us the grace to have dominion over our senses, and to correct our depraved passions. Amen. (1 Our Father and 3 Hail Marys)

Fifth Salutation

Through the intercession of St. Michael and the celestial Choir of Virtues, may our Lord keep us from falling into temptation, and deliver us from evil. Amen. (1 Our Father and 3 Hail Marys)

Sixth Salutation

Through the intercession of St. Michael and the celestial Choir of Powers, may God vouchsafe to keep our souls from the wiles and the temptations of the devil. Amen. (1 Our Father and 3 Hail Marys)

Seventh Salutation

Through the intercession of St. Michael and the celestial Choir of Principalities, may it please God to fill our hearts with the spirit of true and hearty obedience. Amen. (1 Our Father and 3 Hail Marys)

Eighth Salutation

Through the intercession of St. Michael and the celestial Choir of Archangels, may it please God to grant us the grace of perseverance in the faith, and in all good works, that we may thereby be enabled to attain unto the glory of paradise. Amen. (1 Our Father and 3 Hail Marys)

Ninth Salutation

Through the intercession of St. Michael and the celestial Choir of Angels, may God vouchsafe to grant that they may protect us during life, and after death may lead us into the everlasting glory of heaven. Amen (1 Our Father and 3 Hail Marys)

Say an Our Father on each of the four large concluding beads:

- The first one to St. Michael,
- The second one to St. Gabriel,
- The third one to St. Raphael,
- The fourth one to our Guardian Angel.

End the Chaplet with the following prayer:

Saint Michael, glorious prince, chief and champion of the heavenly Host, guardian of the souls of men, conqueror of the rebellious angels, steward of the palace of God under our divine King Jesus Christ, our worthy leader, endowed with superhuman excellence and virtues: vouchsafe to free us from all evil, who with full confidence have recourse to thee; and by thy incomparable protection enable us to make progress every day in the faithful service of our God. Amen.

Let us pray. Pray for us, most blessed Michael, Prince of the Church of Jesus Christ.

R. That we may be made worthy of his promises.

Almighty and Eternal God, who in thine own marvelous goodness and pity didst, for the common salvation of man, choose thy glorious Archangel Michael to be the prince of thy Church: make us worthy, we pray, to be delivered by his beneficent protection from all our enemies, that, at the hour of our death, none of them may approach to harm us; rather do Thou vouchsafe unto us that by the same Archangel Michael, we may be introduced into the presence of Thy most high and divine majesty. Through the merits of the same Jesus Christ our Lord. Amen.

My dear Brothers:

May the Lord give you peace.

Last Friday, on the feast of Our Lady of Mount Carmel, Pope Francis, surprised the Church with news that overturned the Liturgical life of the Church, especially from the vantage point of what many of us have come to understand from the Apostolic Letter of Pope Benedict XVI's 2007 motu proprio: *Summorum Pontificum*, which allowed any priest to use the traditional (older) rite of the Mass without the permission of his bishop.

In issuing *Traditionis Custodes* our Holy Father outlined changes and restrictions in the celebration of the Sacred Liturgy in the Extraordinary Form. I am certain that this news has caused some distress for some of you and some of the faithful of our Diocese. I feel it is necessary to study the decree further for deeper clarity and to ensure a complete understanding of the Holy Father's intentions. While I work toward faithfully implementing the *Traditionis Custodes* in a manner that best serves the need of the faithful and our Diocese I grant permission for priests of the Diocese who have previously been celebrating the Liturgy using the 1962 Roman Missal to continue celebrating Masses at the times and locations in which they had previously been established. They must be celebrated with all relevant liturgical and disciplinary norms. No new celebrations of the traditional Latin Mass may be scheduled at this time.

I request that priests who are celebrating according to the *Missale Romanum* of 1962 contact my office over the next couple of weeks, in writing, with a formal request in order to be considered for faculties (Art. 5) and so we might better determine locations where the Sacred Liturgy, celebrated in Extraordinary Form, may be scheduled in order to spiritually nourish those that have a unity to the Eucharist in this liturgical form.


