

## **Building and Grounds Update**

We have made many improvements over the past months to both our parish properties. We plan further improvements before the fiscal year end of June 30, 2022:

- St John's carport repairs were recently completed, involving the replacing of steel supports holding up the carport that had deteriorated, and enhancing the structure with a stone veneer finish that will protect the structure many years into the future.
- At St. Alphonsus, a new computer and software upgrade for the HVAC controlling the school environment, as part of the Love One Another campaign, was recently installed. This initial improvement will help better manage energy and diagnose issues. Additional hardware improvements are planned this year, (e.g. thermostats for some of the classrooms).
- St John's has placed an order for a new heating unit / furnace to replace two furnaces in the lower level that heat the hall and part of the church sanctuary. The old furnaces were both showing rust/wear in the heat exchangers. The new furnace, as configured, can replace the two existing units and should help save on energy costs.
- Cement repair work will commence shortly at St Alphonsus on the concrete and foundations in a number of areas where existing cement cover is cracking or breaking away. These include the church, school / ADA ramp, Emmaus center, and the wall around the prayer garden. We hope to complete these repairs by the end of June.

Thank you to our Building & Grounds Committee, volunteers, and maintenance and cleaning staff for helping to repair and maintain the facilities and outdoor properties that we are so blessed to enjoy.
