#### Infant Baptism (Preparation Required)

Must be a registered member and attend Baptismal Preparation Class. Please contact the Parish office to schedule baptism. There are no baptisms during the season of Lent.

#### **First Holy Communion**

Students should have a minimum of two years of Faith Formation. If a student is being enrolled in Grade 2 without previous formation, they will receive 1st Holy Communion in Grade 3

#### Confirmation

Students attending public school are expected to have completed Grade 9 & 10 faith formation classes prior to joining the Grade 11 Confirmation class. Students attending Catholic High School still need to attend faith formation Confirmation classes in Grade 11.
