

# From the desk of Fr. John Pfister

Growing up the second born of eight children made for a happy childhood in my hometown of Fort Branch, Indiana. My schooling began at Holy Cross Grade School and progressed to Gibson Southern High School and then Indiana University. Later, I earned graduate degrees from the University of Southern Indiana and Saint Meinrad.

I worked in a succession of banks in southwestern Indiana, starting as a teller and ending as a Sr. Loan Officer. I also taught business and computer subjects at a junior college at night school and on the internet.

Over time, my home parish asked me to participate in stewardship, finance, and leading the rosary. Active participation in the life of the Church led me from being a Sunday Catholic to growing into a daily Catholic.

After a life-altering Cursillo, I left the bank, becoming the pastoral assistant for my home-parish pastor, Father Tony Ernst. This led me to the seminary, where I took all my electives in Biblical Studies; I graduated and was ordained in 2017.

After two years as an associate at St. John the Baptist, Newburgh for Father Tom Kessler, I became the administrator and then pastor of Saint Mary, Sullivan, and Saint Joan of Arc, Jasonville. I offered weekly Mass at the Carlisle prison for three years, a spiritually uplifting experience. In my spare time, I have a correspondence ministry with Catholics in twenty-two states.

I began my term as Pastor of St. Isidore Parish on Wednesday, June 29, 2022.






