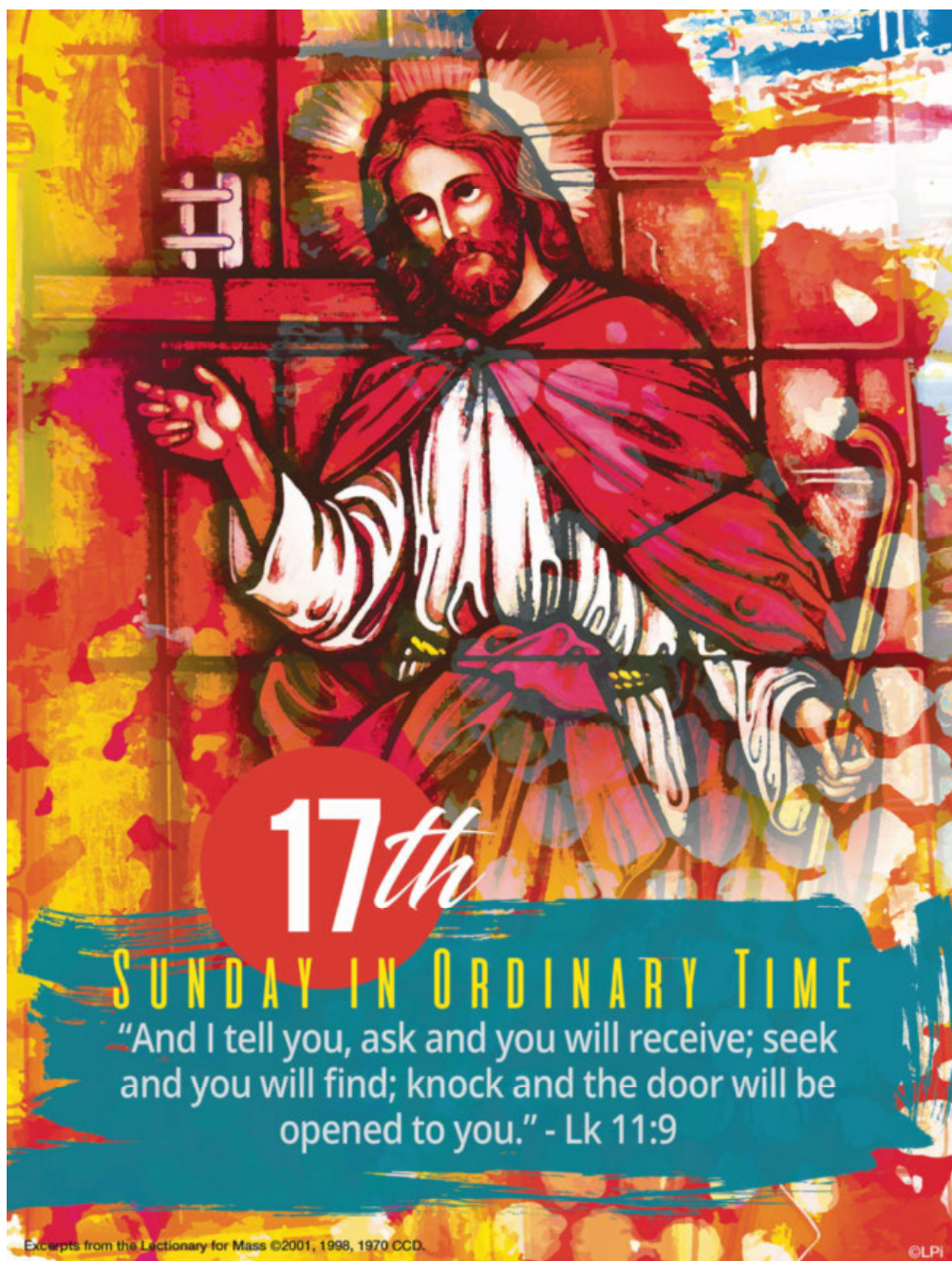

From the desk of Fr. John Pfister:

I spent Sunday evening visiting with my parents, a few siblings, and their spouses, and on several occasions, one of us “googled” something or another. These were mere “data points,” just one piece of information. Perhaps they added to our lively conversation, I’d like to think so. But as I reflected on my day, I wondered whether our glut of information might actually undermine our ability to see the truly important.

The Catholic Church is transformative. In my own experience, I have been moved by faith to embrace the deeply-held beliefs therein. In the Church, family is sacrosanct; each family is bound one to another by Church, in a sort of extended family. This brings us to value in a specific way each member of the Church. In other words, we care for one another.

The Catholic Church is important to the history of the world. When the Church of Jesus Christ moves as one, we have the power to change the world. Here in the States, whether you are speaking about education, health care, or ethics, the Church is vital in the past and present. In Church, we live out our hope for the future.

The Catholic Church extends its hand in mercy. The spiritual teaching of the Church urges us to help others; the sick, the poor, the elderly, and the grieving are given special attention. Just this week, I witnessed the good works of the Knights of Columbus and Saint Vincent DePaul at St. Isidore.

The Catholic Church is redemptive; salvation is our ultimate goal. In the daily Sacraments of the Eucharist and Reconciliation, we prepare for our life hereafter. Continual conversion becomes routine. When all other things drop away, we remember our aim, eternal life. This is the truly important takeaway of my reflection; heaven awaits.

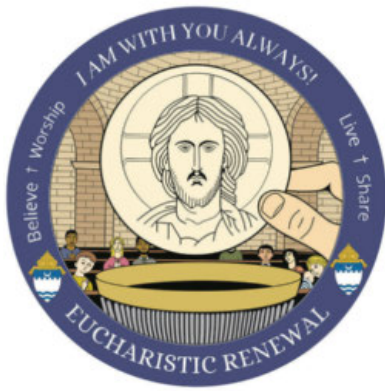

Eucharistic Renewal

All of the parishes and Catholic schools throughout our diocese—together with all of the dioceses in the U.S.—are participating in an extraordinary initiative to foster renewed devotion to the Real Presence of Jesus in the Eucharist and greater appreciation for the awesome gift of the Mass. The Renewal will lead up to a National Eucharistic Congress in Indianapolis from July 17-21, 2024.

Traveling Eucharistic Miracle Exhibits will be periodically present at every parish throughout the diocese. St. Isidore is hosting the traveling eucharistic miracle exhibit the week of July 26- August 2. This exhibit is based on the work of Blessed Carlo Acutis, a 15 year old saint, who dedicated his time at age 11 to creating a website about eucharistic miracles. His website was completed in 2005, a year before his death. We will receive an exhibit 6 times throughout this year. The first exhibit will be on display at the St. Celestine campus for use during the Week of Work and Worship.
