

From the desk of Craig Gehlhausen: Youth Minister

Where can we belong? This past weekend I had the opportunity to work my 12th Teens Encounter Christ retreat weekend. So many good things happened on this retreat that I could talk for a long time. This community showed me once again that God is truly present and working in this retreat. God reminded me that I belong here in the community and that I am loved and seen. TEC works so well for students because it provides the 5 basic needs for them.

The need to belong is an important need for our students. TEC offers a chance for our students to have a safe place to express their doubts. Whether these doubts are about their faith, their abilities, or about God reaching out to them. They are given guidance and the chance to figure things out on their own. They are treated as adults with their own faith story and not just the faith story of their family.

The community of TEC welcomes our students so much that many times on the first day students already feel as though they don't want to leave, even with two days yet to go. This community has had such a great impact on me that since my first TEC, 15 years ago, I couldn't see myself anywhere else. I have been away from the community for 6 years and yet was welcomed back this past weekend with open arms.

In TEC you always belong and are welcome. It doesn't matter who you are or where you come from, you are welcome. God is calling us to grow in our faith and is present in this community, so come grow with us and find your place to belong.




