

From the desk of Deacon Mike:

What's the best way for our young people to fall in love with our Faith? The answer is the same for all of us – we learn to Love as God loves when we give ourselves away selflessly, just like Jesus did. In our Week of Work and Worship last week, we put this into practice. Teens, young adults, adult volunteers, and staff came together to create a fulfilling spiritual experience which benefitted many in the community.

Every day started with prayer or Mass, sharing of a meal, then we headed out to our worksites. More than half of the work was FIREWOOD! (Isn't July the Perfect time to split firewood? :) Actually, God blessed us with lower temperatures - and he blessed us with RAIN – LOTS OF IT – which also means MUD - LOTS OF IT. Fortunately, one of our resident saints in the parish moved all of the firewood into a barn so we could work without getting drenched. Splitting and stacking, splitting and stack, splitting and stacking... our young folks might never want to look at another piece of firewood. We also did yard work, power-washed some houses, washed windows, pulled weeds, weed-eated, spread mulch – basically any job we could find to help out.

In the evenings, we shared another meal and then enjoyed music, skits, and a speaker to give us something to stretch our minds. We had confession, personal prayer, adoration, and a personal encounter with Jesus.

It's hard to put into words what this week meant to everyone, but basically it was wonderful for rebuilding community – both among ourselves – and with the people we served.

(Thanks to all who helped with food, driving, splitting, lining-up jobs, providing tools, praying, music, technical support, all the many ways our parish supports our ministries.)
